







## Château Roquetaillade la Grange - red Graves Guignard Brothers

For four centuries, the passion for wine enlivens the Guignard family. Pierre and Jean Guignard first, self-taught, hardworking and visionary purposes, who, in the 60's restored the Estate and separated it from the former vineyard. The sons of Pierre took over the family business in 1996: Dominique, Agricultural Engineer, is the Chairman of the Union of Graves and he is the creator of the Route des Vins de Bordeaux, Sauternes and Graves; Bruno, the Oenologist, has comprehensive experience in prestigious areas and joined the family property in 1992; Pascal, Quality Engeneer, joined his brothers in 1996 to rule the entire management of the Properties. Guignard Brothers, it is above all a human adventure. All together, they modernized the Estate and now run the most beautiful set of Graves region, the birthplace of Bordeaux wines. Their phylosophy is respect for the environment through sustainable farming.

This rubis coloured red Graves impresses with a powerfull bouquet: red berries, toast and spices. The elegant palate reveals liquorice, moka and cinnamon.



Roquetaillage La Grange wines are delicious young, between 16° and 18° C, with red meat or strong cheeses. After a few years, they are lovely with veal or lamb, and more delicate cheeses.
