



Bàrbara Forés Blanc 2013

Winery: Celler Barbara Fores

D.O.: Terra Alta

Wine Type: White

Variety: 95% Garnacha Blanca, 5% Viognier

Alcohol: 14 %

Named for the great-great-grandmother of the family, *Bàrbara Forés* means the respect and the tradition in the art of making wine, transmitted from parents to children during over one hundred years in our family.

Celler Bàrbara Forés is located in the Terra Alta region, which is sheltered by *la Serra de Pàdols* and *Serra de Cavalls* mountains, and by the Ebro river and its tributaries. It's altitude of up to 600 meters and it's close proximity to the Mediterranean also allow for favorable growing conditions.

White Garnacha (95%) and Viognier (5%) are hand harvested early in the season and left to macerate in cold temperatures for approximately 20 hours. After skin removal, a gentle fermentation takes place in stainless steel tubs for 15 days.

PRODUCTION: 12,000 bottles of 75cl and 1500 bottles of 50cl were produced.
