

“Where is Your Treasure”

Scripture: Matthew 6:19-24

Read

Have one student read Matthew 6:19-24 out loud.

1. Ice Breaker (3–4 minutes)

Question:

If your house was on fire, what are you making sure to get before you get out safely?

Transition:

“The things we bring reveal what we value most.”

2. Read the Passage (3–4 minutes)

Read Matthew 6:19–24 out loud together.

Ask:

- What word or phrase stood out to you?

3. Discussion (8–10 minutes)

1. What do you think Jesus means by “treasure”?

What are some common “treasures” for people your age today?

2. If someone looked at your screen time, schedule, what you did in your free time, and spending, what would they say your treasure is?

3. Jesus says you can’t serve two masters.

What are things (besides money) that compete with God for first place in your life?

Keep it moving — don’t let one question take too long.

4. Application & Challenge (3–4 minutes)

Ask:

- What is one thing that competes for your heart right now?
- What’s one small step you can take this week to put God first in that area?

Weekly Challenge:

Before you get out of the bed each day, pause for 30 seconds and pray, “God, help me make You my treasure today.”

5. Closing Prayer

Take and closing prayer needs, pray for those and then end with the portion below.

“God, show us what has our hearts. Help us choose things that last. Teach us to trust You more than anything else competing for our attention. Amen.”
