

## Fall River County Fair 2026 SD Micro Derby Outlaw Class

Entry \$40

### Frame/Body

1. Mowers must be belt driven, no chain or shaft drive allowed, Mower must have working clutch
2. Mowers must have leg guards made of steel, 1" minimum square tube or 2" angle.
3. Must have a minimum of two up rights having no more than 12" space between them, sheet metal is an acceptable filler with a minimum thickness of 3/16" thick.
4. Leg guards can attach in three spots per side with no more than 3" mounting point
5. Cage tubing cannot exceed 3"x3" tubing
6. Three belly bars are allowed.
7. From where foot sits to top of cage must be at least 6"
8. Cage cannot extend further than 3" past the fender or be any wider than 42"
9. Cage must not extend forward past the rear of the front tires or rearward past the front of rear tires.
10. A safety hoop is allowed with a 3"x3" maximum size tubing
11. Hoop may not exceed 42" width or 3" past fender and may not attach to fenders of frame, any mower with safety hoop attached to fenders of frame will be classified as an outlaw
12. The safety hoop must be above the rear tire.
13. No bracing from leg guards to bumpers or fenders.
14. Cage must not cover the tires as viewed from the side.
15. The front bumper may not exceed **half** the width of the front tires and must have a minimum of 4" of flat surface. No round bumpers allowed. Nosing of bumper or pointed bumper is allowed
16. Front bumper cannot exceed 12" from front of frame to front of bumper
17. Front bumpers have a maximum of 18" ground clearance to the **bottom** of the bumper.
18. Rear bumper may not exceed **half** the width of rear tires, and must have 4" of flat surface
19. The frame can have **18 inches of plating in the front** no thicker than 1/8 inch thick
20. The motor plate bolted onto the frame cannot exceed 10"x10" and may not be welded to the frame. You will be allowed 4 original bolts through motor plate and 4 additional bolts to mount plate to frame
21. Oil filter guards and engine guards are allowed but can not be mounted to or touching the cage.
22. Mower fenders and counsel must be bolted on and may not be welded to frame.
23. Mowers must have hoods and fenders and have a lawnmower appearance.

### Drivetrain

1. Mower must have a lawn mower engine.
2. Blocks must **start out** no bigger than 27HP.
3. Fuel tank must be securely mounted and not leak fuel. If running any fuel besides gas must have a fuel additive.
4. Battery must be securely mounted.
5. Tires must have air in them

6. A plate is allowed on the rims but must not protrude over the bead of the tire any more than 1.5”.
7. Wheel plates that cover tire can not be thicker than 1/4”
8. Mower must have a kill switch or key that is red or painted red.

## **Driver**

1. Must be 16 years of age, if not 18 you must have parental consent and a guardian present above the age of 21.
2. All drivers and pit members must have a pit pass, all pits are hot zones and a waiver must be signed.
3. All drivers must wear a full-face/motorcross helmet, short or long sleeve shirt, jeans or work style pants, closed toe shoes and preferably leather or some type of gloves.
4. No alcohol consumption allowed by any drivers before or during the event.
5. Mowers must not leave the boundaries of the track.
6. Stay on the mower at all times even after the stick is broken. If the driver gets off the mower at any time besides emergency you will be disqualified. You may remove from the mower during a red flag to move to safety.
7. Driver is allowed 1 minute to make contact if the driver does not make contact, the driver will be disqualified.
8. You may work on a mower from the seat of your mower on the track at your own risk and will still be a live target.
9. No purposely flipping mowers or direct back hits allowed. A back hit will be treated as a driver door. One warning then if you had to be talked to a second time you will be disqualified. Now if you are using your back as a contact point and hitting with it your back is fair game.
10. No changing tires, belts, parts during the event. Any part of the mower that becomes disconnected from the mower may not be put back on at any time.
11. SD Micro Derby officials have the final say and do reserve the right to disqualify drivers for actions on the track or any other un sportsmanship actions (any un sportsmanship actions will result in a disqualification for the entire event with no refund)
12. Anyone who tecs in late will be charged an additional \$10.
13. No arguing with any officials if this happens you could be asked to leave the event without refund.

### POWER WHEELS Class RULES

1) This is supposed to be fun for kids, parents please let them have Fun!

Judges can rule that children won't participate if there are modifications to the car more than those allowed as stated here.

2) Kids 3-8 years of age may participate. There will be two age groups 3-6 and 7-12 years old.

3) Derby is limited to 6, 12 or (20 Volt for 7 to 12 allowed volt power wheels ONLY. No connecting multiple batteries together. (this makes the vehicle move too fast and makes it unsafe for younger group

4) No added reinforcements

5) All doors and tailgates must be strapped shut. No sharp edges. Use zip ties or duct tape (or other flexible products to make them stay shut.

7) Do NOT raise or lower. They must be the stock height that came from the store.

8) Batteries must be secured and away from the child

9) Decorative changes can be made to the Power Wheels to make it look like a derby car, however, there can be no reinforcement to the Power Wheels. Changes and additions can ONLY be decorative. (ie header pipes sticking up, painting the car, etc)

10) Helmets are required. Bicycle helmets are okay.

11) Shoes or sneakers are required. NO Sandals

12) Must have a seat belt on at all times.

13) no passengers

14) Everyone must pre-register as all participants will receive a prize.

15) When choosing a Power Wheels for your child, please keep in mind these vehicles will be running into each other (like bumper cars or derby cars. The Power Wheels must be the kind that the child sits IN not ON.

16) NO TRACTORS, 4wheelers or MOTORCYCLES. However razors or utv ok with cardboard or plastic over doors

17) One parent per driver will be allowed in the Pit area.

# 2026 SD Micro Derby stock modified class Demolition Mower Rules

Entry Fee: \$30

1. Mower must be a factory available lawn mower, no garden tractor. (No homemade frames.)
2. No rear engine lawn mowers are allowed.
3. Engine must be a factory lawn mower engine such as Briggs & Stratton, Tecumseh, Onan, etc. by
4. Transaxles must be factory available mower transaxles, but any reinforcing and/or welding of spider gears are permitted.
5. Engine bay reinforcing is permitted, but must be contained inside of the hood and must maintain factory body lines.
6. All mowers must run a factory hood and fenders and have the hood either screwed or welded down to the dash panel around the driver's area. (Note: If the hood is fiberglass you can make one out of sheet metal only, but must be the same size as the fiberglass one.)
7. Mowers must have good brakes and forward and reverse gears at the start of the heat.
8. Gas tank must be secured and have a cap on it. (If any gas at all is leaking, you will be asked to shut it down.)
9. Leg guards are mandatory and must be bolted and/or welded from rear fender to front of foot rest or frame. It may cross through the rear of the engine to tie side to side.
10. A rear bumper is permitted, but is not allowed to extend more than 4 inches out and it must stay in between the tires; also, no spikes, sharp edges or any protrusions allowed. (Bumpers can be home made with no larger than 3 in sq. tubing no thicker than 1/4in or equivalent shape or size.) A v bumper or also called nosed are allowed
11. Re-gearing and changing of pulleys to increase speed is permitted and encouraged.
12. Any and all drivetrain modifications are permitted, but must stay belt driven. Absolutely no chain driven setups or shaft type setups
13. All mowers must use lawn mower type wheels; rim bead guards, tractor threads and cut tires will be permitted, but no tire chains or dual wheels will be allowed .
14. Mower decks and hardware must be removed.
15. All headlights and any other glass and plastics within contact areas must be removed before you enter the pits.

16. Batteries will be permitted; they must be sealed, gel or dry cell type. The battery must be mounted behind the engine or under the seat and be well secured.

17. Front bumpers are allowed not to go past the edge of the wheel at full turn, and not exceed 5 inches from the front hood and no larger than 3 in. ¼ inch thickness max. Must be unobstructed and able to see through or send wire through.

18. You can build up the front of the frame and underneath the grill to hit with. The front of the mower must be a smooth finish for safety.

19. For safety, if a mower does roll over, all drivers must stop and wait until that driver up-rights his mower and gets off the track.

20. Please put your number on each side of your mower or the hood visible from the side or helmet so we can track the winners.

21. 321 rule: 3 restarts, 2 cause or be the receiver of tipovers or rollovers, 1 minute of non movement or no hits (sandbagging)

22. We will go over all ground rules in a mower's driver's meeting before the heat.

24. Mower inspection will be done by the volunteers. If you see something, ask questions and learn. This is a new sport and we want it to grow. We will have an official walking through the pits before the heat. If there is any misunderstanding of the rules, please get with me or an official. Keep in mind when building your mower, safety first for you and the mower you're hitting.

Before any payout, we may ask to look inside the mower for any violations to rules such as improper batteries or chain driven setups or shaft type setups.

1. Mower motor must be no bigger than 27H.P. no built motors allowed or governor bypass allowed
2. Tires of choice no filled or solid tires allowed
3. Tires must be lawn turf tires not cleated tires allowed and must hold and have air in them
4. Battery must be securely mounted
5. Fuel tank must be securely mounted and not leak fuel
6. Only added metal allowed is leg guards, and rear bumper
7. Mower must have hood and fenders
8. Mower must have leg guards made of steel, 1" minimum square tube, 2" angle with a minimum of two uprights having no more than 12" space between them, sheet metal is an acceptable filler with a minimum thickness of 3/16". Leg guards can attach in three spots per side with no more than 3" attachment at each point, cage tubing cannot exceed 2"x2" tubing, and 3 belly bars are allowed. Top bar of leg cage must be at least 6" higher than where the drivers footrest
9. Mower must be belt driven
10. The driver must be 9-14 and must have a parent consent waiver and the same parent must be on sidelines behind judges during the event.
11. Mower must have kill switch must be red or painted red
12. Mower must have working clutch
13. Rear bumper may not exceed past half the width of tires and cannot exceed past rear axle
14. Front bumper not allowed
15. No pulley swaps allowed
16. No blocked tires
