

## 2025 fall river Outlaw Class

Entry \$30

### Frame/Body

Mowers must be belt driven, no chain or shaft drive allowed, Mower must have working clutch

Mowers must have leg guards made of steel, 1" minimum square tube or 2" angle.

Must have a minimum of two up rights having no more than 12" space between them, sheet metal is an acceptable filler with a minimum thickness of 3/16" thick.

Leg guards can attach in three spots per side with no more than 3" mounting point

Cage tubing cannot exceed 3"x3" tubing

Three belly bars are allowed.

From where foot sits to top of cage must be at least 6"

Cage cannot extend further than 3" past the fender or be any wider than 42"

Cage must not extend forward past the rear of the front tires or rearward past the front of rear tires.

A safety hoop is allowed with a 3"x3" maximum size tubing

Hoop may not exceed 42" width or 3" past fender and may not attach to fenders of frame, any mower with safety hoop attached to fenders of frame will be classified as an outlaw

Safety hoop must be above the rear tire.

No bracing from leg guards to bumpers or fenders.

Cage must not cover the tires as viewed from the side.

Front bumper may not exceed half the width of the front tires and must have a minimum of 4" of flat surface. No round or pointed bumpers allowed.

Front bumper cannot exceed 12" from front of frame to front of bumper

Front bumpers have a maximum of 18" ground clearance to the bottom of the bumper.

Rear bumper may not exceed half the width of rear tires, and must have 4" of flat surface

Again no round or pointed bumpers allowed.

Frame can have 18 inches of plating per side with no more than 6" of total surface (examples: 6" flat no more than 1" thick, 3"x3" angle, or 1.5" tubing. Total surface of material must not exceed a total of 6").

Plating area is from rear of front axle notch to front of rear axle housing at frame mount.

Motor plate welded in the frame cannot exceed 13" from front to back, and must be no wider than the frame.

If you are running a plate mounted to the motor it may not exceed 13" from front to back or any wider than frame. This may be bolted to the welded in motor plate.

Oil filter guards and engine guards are allowed but can not be mounted to or touching the cage.

Mower fenders and counsel must be bolted on and may not be welded to frame.

Mowers must have hoods and fenders and have a lawnmower appearance.

### Drivetrain

Mower must have a lawn mower engine.

Blocks must start out no bigger than 27HP.

Fuel tank must be securely mounted and not leak fuel. If running any fuel besides gas must have a fuel additive.

Battery must be securely mounted.

Tires must have air in them

A safety hoop is allowed with a 3"x3" maximum size tubing. Hoop may not exceed 42" width or 3" past fender and may not attach to fenders of frame, any mower with safety hoop attached to fenders of frame will be classified as an outlaw. Safety hoop must be above the rear tire.

A plate is allowed on the rims but must not protrude over the bead or the tire any more than 1.5 .

Wheel plates that cover tire can not be thicker than 1/4"

Mower must have a kill switch or key that is red or painted red.

Driver

Must be 16 years of age, if not 18 you must have parental consent.

All drivers and pit members must have a pit pass, all pits are hot zones and a waiver must be signed.

All drivers must wear a full-face helmet, short or long sleeve shirt, jeans or work style pants, closed toe shoes.

No alcohol consumption allowed by any drivers before the event.

Mowers must not leave the boundaries of the track.

Stay on the mower at all times even after the stick is broken. If the driver gets off the mower at any time besides emergency you will be disqualified.

Driver is allowed 1 minute to make contact if the driver does not make contact, the driver will be disqualified.

You may work on mower from the seat of your mower on the track at your own risk and will still be a live target.

No purposely flipping mowers or direct back hits allowed. A back hit will be treated as a driver door. One warning then if you had to be talked to a second time you will be disqualified. Now if you are using your back as a contact point and hitting with it your back is fair game.

No changing tires, belts, parts during the event. Any part of the mower that becomes disconnected from the mower may not be put back on at any time.

Fall River Mowers officials have the final say and do reserve the right to disqualify drivers for actions on the track or any other un sportsmanship actions (any un sportsmanship actions will result in a disqualification for the entire event with no refund)

Anyone who techs in late will be charged an additional \$10.

No arguing with any officials if this happens you could be asked to leave the event without refund.
