FAILURE TO DO SO MAY RESULT IN PERMANENT EXPULSION FROM THE PROPERTY WITHOUT A REFUND. SERIOUS OFFENSES WILL BE REPORTED TO THE KINGS COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE. THE RSO OR CARETAKER OF THIS FACILITY HAS THE AUTHORITY OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS TO ENFORCE ALL RULES AND REGULATIONS.

## **GENERAL CLUB RULES**

- 1. CHECKING IN: EVERYONE MUST SCAN THEIR MEMBERSHIP CARD AT THE GATE OR PURCHASE A DAY PASS TO BE ON LSC PROPERTY. (NOTE: YOU MUST SCAN YOUR MEMBERSHIP CARD EVEN IF THE GATE IS UP). MEMBERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ACTIONS OF THEIR GUESTS.
- 2. RANGE FLAGS: The first shooter on the range raises the Range Flag indicating "Live Fire." The last shooter to leave the range lowers the flag. Trap, Skeet and 300 Ranges have their own Baker Flags.
- 3. **CLEAN UP AFTER YOURSELF:** Pick up all trash, dud rounds and casings and put them in the designated containers provided. Return target frames to the target frame shed. Keep our range maintained!
- 4. MINIMUM MEMBERSHIP AGE IS 18. Anyone under that age must be covered by their parent or guardian's membership and always supervised by an adult family member.
- 5. EMERGENCIES: Dial 911 & contact the office. First aid gear is found in the clubhouse.

## **GUN SAFETY AND RANGE RULES**

- 1. ALWAYS KEEP THE GUN POINTED IN A SAFE DIRECTION which is downrange. NEVER dry fire behind the firing line.
- ALWAYS KEEP YOUR FINGER OFF THE TRIGGER UNTIL YOU ARE ON TARGET AND READY TO SHOOT and then only shoot paper targets attached to the wooden and cardboard frames. <u>DAMAGING THE WOODEN FRAMES OR STANDS</u> <u>WILL RESULT IN A FINE</u>. <u>YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR EVERY BULLET THAT LEAVES YOUR GUN</u>. Be sure your bullets are hitting the berm directly behind the target.
- 3. ALWAYS KEEP YOUR GUN UNLOADED until you are on the firing line. Once firing has ceased, unload your gun before leaving the firing line. Holster or bench the gun with slide or bolt locked back or cylinder open. (LEO & CCW Exceptions Apply)
- 4. **PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT REQUIRED:** Eye and ear protection; closed toes shoes. Hats recommended.
- 5. QUALIFICATION OR ORIENTATION REQUIRED FOR THE FOLLOWING: Knife & Axe Throwing, Trap, Skeet, 200/300 Rifle Range & non LSC steel target use.
- 6. FIRING LINE: All shooters must be on the same firing line. DO NOT STAGGER YOUR LINE ON WALK-UP RANGES (15 Yard, 25 Yard, and western 50 Yard). The firing line for <u>NON-WALK-UP RANGES</u> shall be seated at the bench or the forward edge of the concrete pad for all other shooting positions. (EXCEPTION: Shooting 25-yard targets on the 25/50 range can only be done from the seated position).
- 7. MISFIRES/HANG FIRES: Keep the gun pointed down range and wait at least 30 seconds before clearing it.

## 8. PROHIBITED ACTIONS:

- Handling Firearms with People Down Range (Red Line Rule)
- Firing Outside of Ranges or Over the Berm
- Walking on the Berm
- Feeding Animals or Hunting on Property

- Alcohol On Property (Includes Drinking 4 Hours Prior To Shooting)
- Shotguns on the Pistol/Rifle Ranges (100 yd exception)
- Lead On Skeet Range
- Speeds over 5 mph

- Rim Fire Ammo On 200/300 Yard
- Slugs, Pistol, or Rifle Ammo on the Tactical Shotgun Hanger
- Paintball, Chemical Agents or Tracer Ammunition
