

Grain-Free Pastured Cow and Hog Shares

Thank you for your interest in purchasing a cow or hog share! We appreciate your desire to support local, family owned, regenerative agriculture!



Animal shares are the most economical way to get an assortment of cuts of truly grain free, rotationally grazed, all natural beef. Knowing your farmer and cutting out the middle man provides the greatest possible peace of mind that you aren't paying top dollar for a bunch of marketing buzz words. All of our animals are raised completely naturally and live pastured lives outside 24.77. This increases Vitamin D absorption, fresh air intake, and decreases fecal matter being inhaled.
Living in healthier conditions results in healthier animals that do not require antibiotics, vaccinations, medications, or added hormones.

Our cows, being ruminant animals not designed to digest anything other than foliage and forage, get no supplemental feed. They eat grass spring-fall as we rotate them through different pastures. During the winter they eat hay that we raise right here on our own farm to ensure it's the cleanest possible hay.

Our pigs, being omnivores do require some protein supplementation. They receive peanut meal and milo rations, keeping their diet grain-free, soy-free, and non-gmo.




