Teddywidder Sales Policy and Purchase Agreement

Thank you for considering one of our precious Teddywidders! Our bunnies are raised with love and care and are sold **as PETS ONLY** unless breeding rights have been discussed and purchased separately. We take the well-being of our rabbits seriously and aim to match them with families who will provide lifelong, loving homes. Please read and understand our entire policy before reserving a bunny.

Our Commitment to You

We are committed to raising happy, healthy bunnies and ensuring they transition successfully into their new homes. To protect the well-being of our animals, we:

- Reserve the right to refuse the sale of a bunny if we feel the home is not suitable.
- Reserve the right to ask questions to ensure our bunnies will be properly cared for.

Reserving Your Bunny

- A deposit is required to reserve a bunny. Please do not place a deposit until you have been approved.
- Bunnies are available for pickup at 8 weeks of age or older.
- Pickup must occur within **7 days** of reservation. Failure to pick up your bunny within this window may result in a boarding fee or the bunny being relisted.

Payment Policies

- **Deposits are non-refundable.** No switching reservations to a different bunny once reserved.
- No refunds unless a health issue or death occurs while the bunny is in our care.
- The remaining balance is due on the day of pickup.

Health and Guarantees

- To the best of our knowledge, all rabbits are healthy at the time of pickup.
- We do not guarantee gender, size, wool type, ear carriage, or personality.
- Teddywidders generally range from 2 to 4 pounds, but individual sizes may vary.
- We encourage buyers to inspect their bunny at pickup. After the bunny leaves our care, we are not liable for any accidents, illness, injury, mis-gendering, or death.

Care Requirements

- **Teddywidders must be housed indoors** in a climate-controlled environment.
- They require regular grooming to prevent mats and maintain coat health.
- They must be provided a complete and balanced diet, primarily consisting of quality hay, fresh greens, and rabbit-safe pellets.

Return Policy

• If, at any time, you are unable to care for your bunny, we require first right of refusal. This means you must offer the bunny back to us before rehoming it elsewhere. No refunds will be given.

Breeding Policy

- We sell our bunnies as pets only.
- Breeding rights must be purchased separately and must be discussed in advance.
- Unauthorized breeding will result in legal action.
- Backyard breeding is strictly prohibited.

Communication and Waitlist

- Waitlist customers must respond within 48 hours once contacted about available bunnies.
- Lack of response within **5 days** from first contact may result in forfeiture of your deposit and bunny reservation.

Photography and Website Content

• Use of our photos, videos, and written material is prohibited without proper credit.

Agreement

- By placing a deposit or adopting a bunny from us, you **AGREE to our full Sales Policy**.
- We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone at any time for any reason.
- Pricing and policy are subject to change at any time.
