Our second basket is a "**Generic Tailgate**" - bring all things tailgate - platter or chip bowl, basting brush, cutting board, insect covers for plates, hamburger press, kabob skewers, meat thermometer, oven mitts, tongs, thermos, cookbook, apron, grilling spatula, grill cleaning brush, marinating containers, sauces....

Fabric Requirements -

- 2 3/4 yds of multicolored focus fabric and binding
- 1 3/4 yards complementary fabric # 1 (see pattern -polka dot on pattern)
- 1/4 yard complementary fabric # 2(see pattern - polka dot in separate colorway)
- 1 3/4 yds background fabric
- 4 yards backing

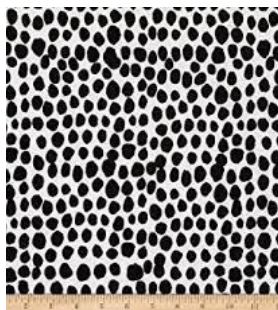
