Community Service & Young Quiltmakers

The following items are needed:

- 1. Poly-Fil for stuffing Me Dolls and Heart Pillows. Please be sure it is machine washable and dryable.
- 2. Fabric for pillow cases 27" x WOF for the body, and 9" x WOF for the cuff (we will not be including accent strips.
- 3. Fabric for pot holders. Each potholder needs 1 Batting 7" x 7", 1 Fabric 7" x 7" and 1 Fabric 9" x 9"
- 4. Young quilters have the following so far: 5x5 charm pack, thread, needles, pins, seam ripper, tape measure, small scissor, sewing machine needles, needle booklet. If you can think of anything else to include, it would be greatly appreciated. We would need 20.

2024 CHALLENGE QUILT KIT

RULES:

- Purchase of the challenge kit INCLUDES PREPAID ENTRY OF YOUR QUILT FOR QUILTFEST 2024.
- Your challenge quilt MUST BE REGISTERED for the show no later than July 25, 2024.
- 2. Your quilt must comply with all Quiltfest general rules, including a 4-inch hanging sleeve and label sewn on the back.
- 3. NO COMMERCIAL PATTERN MAY BE USED.
- 4. Your quilt must be an **ORIGINAL DESIGN** reflecting the 2024 Theme "Sew Your Heart Out".
- 6. Your entry can be any size and any shape (circular, triangle, rhombus, etc.) up to 120 inches (all sides total). Must have a top, batting, backing, and be held together by stitching.
- 7. You must use a recognizable amount of all 3 challenge fabrics on the TOP of your quilt.
- 8. Challenge fabric may **NOT** be used for the backing.
- 9. You may use additional fabrics.
- 10. The design MUST have at least 3 hearts, any of which may be appliqued, pieced, or embroideried.
- 11. Embellishments YES, please!!



Honeybee program payment policy

- Workshops, there will be a \$20 non-refundable deposit (checks only) due at signup. Signup will close when the class is filled, or two weeks prior to event, whichever comes first. The deposit can be transferred to another member to take their place at the workshop.
- Retreats, a non-refundable deposit is due at signup. (checks only) The amount will be determined by the amount of deposit required by the venue.
- Bus trips, there will be a non-refundable deposit due at signup, to hold a place on the bus and reserve the event ticket. Amount will be determined by the cost of the event and bus company deposit (checks only)
- All deposits will be refunded if the workshop or event is canceled
