



AXE PLAY
ACCIDENT WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY FORM

I HEREBY ASSUME ALL OF THE RISKS OF PARTICIPATING IN ANY/ALL ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATED WITH THIS ACTIVITY, including by way of example and not limitation, any risks that may arise from negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons or entities being released, from dangerous or defective equipment or property owned, maintained, or controlled by Axeplay, or because of their possible liability without fault.

In consideration of my application and permitting me to participate in this activity, I hereby take action for myself, my executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors, and assigns as follows:

- (A) I WAVE, RELEASE, AND DISCHARGE from any and all liability, including but not limited to, liability arising from the negligence or fault of the entities or persons released, for my death, disability, personal injury, property damage, property theft, or actions of any kind which may hereafter occur to me including my traveling to and from this activity, THE FOLLOWING ENTITIES OR PERSONS: AXEPLAY/or their owners, directors, officers, employees, volunteers, representatives, and agents, and the activity holders, sponsors, and property owners.
- (B) INDEMNIFY, HOLD HARMLESS, AND PROMISE NOT TO SUE the entities or persons mentioned in (A) paragraph from any and all liabilities or claims made as a result of participation in this activity, whether caused by the negligence of release or otherwise.
I acknowledge that AXEPLAY, and their owners, directors, officers, volunteers, representatives, and agents are NOT responsible for the errors, omissions, acts, or failures to act of any party or entity conducting a specific activity on their behalf.

I acknowledge that this activity may involve a test of a person's physical and mental limits and carries with it the potential for death and serious injury.

I confirm that I have read and understood the Safety Rules attached below and will abide by these.

I hereby consent to receive medical treatment that may be deemed advisable in the event of injury, accident, and/or illness during this activity.

I understand that while participating in this activity I may be photographed. I agree to allow my photo, video, or film likeness to be used for any legitimate purpose by the activity holders, producers, sponsors, organisers, and assigns.

The Accident Waiver and Release of Liability Form shall be construed broadly to provide a release and waiver to the maximum extent permissible under applicable law.

Axe Play Safety Rules

Spectator Rules

Spectators must **NOT** go past the spectator area zone into the throwing zone. This is denoted by the red safety line separating the two zones

Spectators must **NOT** handle the axes and no axes are allowed in the spectator zone

Player Rules

All players must make payment in full before commencing their session

No one must handle an axe until they have read, understood and signed a waiver form

All players must receive instruction prior to playing and should on **NO** account touch an axe if they have not been instructed prior

If a player has been before within the last 3 months they can inform the instructors and may play providing they are confident they remember all the safety rules and read the safety sign

Any player who messes around or acts in a way that puts themselves or others at risk can be removed immediately by the instructors and will not be entitled to a refund

Players must do the following:

Remain in the spectating area until your lane is empty

When finished leave your axe on the log in the throwing area before returning to the spectator area

Throw the axe from the designated area and do not go closer or further from the target than the area indicated

Ask the instructors for help if you are unsure of anything

Throw the axes using the methods shown by your instructor

Players must NOT do the following:

Have consumed alcohol or drugs that will adversely affect you

Remove axes from the throwing area

Open shoes / sandals are not permitted

Have more than one person per lane in the throwing area at any one time

Throw the axes too hard as they could bounce back

Throw the axes anywhere other than the target in your lane
