Personal Gear Trailer: This group is responsible for unpacking Sylvia (grey trailer) Friday night. This includes: Personal gear for the entire troop & common troop gear needed Friday night. Leave all food on the trailer. The food is the responsibility of each patrol

This group is also responsible for packing all personal gear, patrol gear & troop gear for departure on Sunday.

Lanterns and Fire: This group is responsible for setting up and lighting lanterns on Friday night. They will start, tend to and extinguish any fires for the duration of the weekend.

This group is responsible for packing all lanterns before departure from camp. They will also clean any remnants of fire following Leave No Trace Principles.

Water and Trash: This group is responsible for setting up a water hose to water spigot if necessary. They will fill all 5gal water jugs. They will. make Bug Juice if required.

This group will empty, clean and put away 5 gal water jugs at end of campout. They will collect and put away the troop water hose.

This group is responsible for setting up trash bags in camp. They will put trash bags in trailers or dumpsters each evening before bed each night and before leaving the campsite.

Wash Station: These youth will remove the wash station components from the trailer. They will fully set up the wash station. Before each meal the group will throw out the dirty water and begin heating the clean water (heat water for about 7 minutes then turn off burners.)

This group is responsible for putting all of the wash station components on the trailer in the correct location.

Latrine Duty: On your assigned day, this group/ patrol will be sure the latrine is clean. They will be sure there is toilet paper in each stall. They will ensure there is soap at the hand washing sink. The latrine should be swept and cleaned Friday night, at least twice on Saturday and before departure on Sunday.
