1. it Balloons the Federal Deficit — **BETRAYAL**

■ The Law is projected by the CBO*¹ to add \$3.4 trillion to the Federal Deficit over the next 10 years*2*3

4. it Slashes vital programs for vulnerable Americans—BETRAYAL

- Estimated \$1.4 trillion in spending cuts, mainly targeting Medicaid and SNAP (Food Stamps)*3
- Despite these cuts, the deficit will continue to grow due to the scale of the tax reductions.
