BETRAYAL

Americans feel betrayed!

You voted for President Trump's "One Big Beautiful Bill" (OB BB)...

1. it Balloons the Federal Deficit — **BETRAYAL**

- The Law is projected by the CBO^{*1} to add \$3.4 trillion to the Federal Deficit over the next 10 years^{*2*3}

2. it Grants permanent Tax Breaks to the Wealthy — **BETRAYAL**

- The Law includes **\$4.5 trillion in tax reductions**^{*3} over the next decade, primarily by cementing tax breaks for the wealthy and corporations while giving some temporary tax breaks to workers earning far less.
- Between 2026 and 2034, the **bottom 10% of households will lose income** and the **top 10% will gain income**^{*4}
- These cuts also significantly reduce federal revenue over the next decade^{*3}

3. it Imperils the health and safety of millions of Americans— **BETRAYAL**

- The CBO estimates **11.8 million Americans will lose health care** under Medicaid over the next decade^{*2}
- The OB BB reshapes public safety funding across federal and local emergency preparedness programs - with **FEMA** facing major cuts, **NOAA** undergoing structural changes and **local agencies** bracing for tighter budgets.

4. it Slashes vital programs for vulnerable Americans—**BETRAYAL**

- Estimated **\$1.4 trillion in spending cuts**, mainly targeting Medicaid and SNAP (Food Stamps)^{*3}
- Despite these cuts, the deficit will continue to grow due to the scale of the tax reductions.
