



## St. Croix Valley Shrine Club Prepares for an Exciting New Year

The Nobles of the St. Croix Valley Shrine Club had a full agenda at their annual planning and scheduling meeting at the New Richmond American Legion.

The club is planning some changes for 2017 including some new events and changes in current activities.

Roger Keller, the chairman of the Little East West Shrine game reported he had placed a thank you ad in the Osman Shrine magazine expressing appreciation for their participation in the parade. He also reported that the players dinner will again be held on the Wednesday before the game. This year the dinner will be at the American Legion in River Falls.

Keller also reported on behalf of the Shrine Auxiliary. The group held a Christmas Party and raised \$2,800 worth of toys and quilts for the children at the Hospital. Keller expressed his appreciation to Hospital Auxiliary coordinator Tammy Winkelman for her work.

The Auxiliary will collect aluminum cans during 2017 at the Midway Shopping Center in Ellsworth. Look for the sign on the collection container in the parking lot. All proceeds will go to the Hospital.

The club voted to approve \$1,000 for their share of the Trout Pond held each year at the Open House Hospital Day at the Shriners hospital for Children®. They share the cost of the event with the Zuhrah Rod and Gun Club of Minneapolis.

The famous Zor Roadrunners Captain Randy Pfab of River Falls announced needed repairs for the unit have been made. Over the winter months the go karts will receive new bumpers and uniform chain drive clutches which will add to the performance. He also noted some changes in the uniforms for drivers in the coming parade season. A list of the parade units will be coming out soon.

As the new Captain of the Roadrunners, Pfab also presented a new fund

raising plan. Randy said River Moon Coffee of River Falls offered to share income from a special on-line sale of the coffee and chocolate. The business roasts beans to order. The campaign starts in January and wraps up the end of February.

The Nobles also voted to replace the Ellsworth Rod and Gun Chicken Feed with a family Halloween event. The location and details will be coming. Barry Ausen of the Divan reported the Circus will be held in Sparta this year. The St. Croix Valley Shrine club is providing coloring books and a bicycle for the event.

In his membership report, Bob Hering said membership numbers will be ready after the January 15th annual meeting.

The club announced their annual Valentine's Party will be held on Feb 17th at the Ellsworth Masonic Center.

For those that may be in question, here is a very brief explanation of the wording.

Creations.... A Mason initiated into the Shriners International.

Affiliations.... Any noble who has previously demitted from his mother temple and rejoins his mother temple, or any other temple.

Restoration....The return of all rights of membership to a noble who has been suspended from membership.

Demits.... When a noble relinquishes his membership in a temple. Any noble who demits must be in good standing and would return to membership as an affiliation.,

Suspensions.... The deprivation of all rights of membership due to non-payment of dues.

Expired.... He has been visited by the Black Camel.

Resigned.... When a noble voluntarily relinquishes all rights of membership. Any noble who resigns must be in good standing and would have to be a new creation in order to return to membership.

NPDs.... Non-paid dues, a Shriner who is not current with his membership dues.
