Zor Shriners quarterly meeting was called to order at 3:30 P. M. by Chief Rabban C. Miller.

K. Gant gave the opening prayer and all 16 Nobles present joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to our flag. D. Olson moved the agenda as amended be approved and seconded by B. Ausen. Motion Carried.

J. Stelsel moved the minutes of the Quarterly Meeting of July 19, 2016 be approved and seconded by W. Trouten. Motion Carried.

D. Olson explained the Treasurer's report ending September 30, 2016 (See attachment #1) and J. Thorstad moved acceptance of the report and seconded by D. Olson. Motion Carried.

No Petitions or Cold Sands are pending at this meeting. Membership Report: B. Ausen reported since January $\overline{1}$, 2016 we have 31 creations, 4 affiliations, 37 deaths, 2 resignations, 16 restorations and 1 suspension, for plus of 11 members for a total membership of 1391 Nobles as of September 30, 2016. (See attachment #2) Reading the names of departed Nobles: J. Stelsel, Recorder read the names of Imperial Officer, Robert B. Bailey and 6 departed Zor Nobles (See attachment #3) and K. Gant offered a prayer for the departed Nobles Committee Reports: Trustees Report: B. Jones reported both upstairs and down stairs dish washers have been replaced for a

total cost of \$2,200.00, the contract for lawn care and snow plowing have been agreed to for the next 3 years. Zor investments total 1,574,131.00. Interest received was \$44,870.00 which is a 4.8% increase. (See Attachment#4) B. Jones moved acceptance of the report and seconded by D. Olson. Motion Carried.

Hospital Reports: None presented.

Old Business:

Zephyr: J. Thorstad reported he is having a problem getting old and new copies of the Zephyr online and others reported they are able to get them. It was suggested an outline of the steps needed to gain access to the Zephyr online be developed and an article be put in the Zephyr on how to gain access.

Hospital Van Replacement-Wausau Van: C. Miller reported the old red Wausau van is here at the office and is up for sale. If anyone knows of anyone who would be interested in purchasing this van they should contact the office or the Divan.

Quarterly Meetings: J. Thorstad raised the issue of having quarterly meetings in the evening after an event or on a week end so those who work can attend the meetings. C. Miller reported he will make this change next year when quarterly meetings are held.

Ceremonial: J. Harker reported the Ceremonial will be at the Radisson Hotel in La Crosse from December 2 to 4. The Festival of Lights will also be on while we are there.

New Business:





Official Notice of Zor 2017 Annual Meeting and Election of Officers

The official Notice of Zor's 2017 Annual Meeting and Election of Officers Zor Temple's Annual Meeting and election will be held Saturday, January 14, 2017 at the Zor Shriners Center in Madison. A total of 10 Zor officials will be elected and six members of the Appointive Divan named to posts during the election and post-election meeting and installation ceremony. This is the official notice required by Imperial Council:

Election and Installation at Zor Temple on January 14, 2017

Notice is hereby given that the Annual Meeting for Zor Shrine will be held at the Zor Center on Saturday, January 14, 2017, beginning at 1 p.m. at which time annual reports will be presented, officers and representatives elected for the coming year, and such other business transacted as may properly come before the meeting.

ARTICLE 25, Section 325.4 to 325.6 of the Imperial Code reads as follows:

Each Temple must elect its officers and representatives by separate written ballot and by a majority vote of those present and voting. A blanket ballot is prohibited. Said election shall take place at the Temple's annual meeting in January of each year. Nominations must commence not later than 9 p.m. for an evening meeting or 3 p.m. for an afternoon meeting of the day on which the election is held, and when that hour arrives, all other business must immediately cease and not may be transacted until the election is concluded.

ARTICLE 25, Section 325.10(a)

The printing, publication, circulating or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets or other devices, by a Noble suggesting, recommending, opposing or containing the names of proposed candidates for office in the Temple, is prohibited (b) for any violation of section (a), the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending Noble and he may declare the election of said officers void and order a new election.


