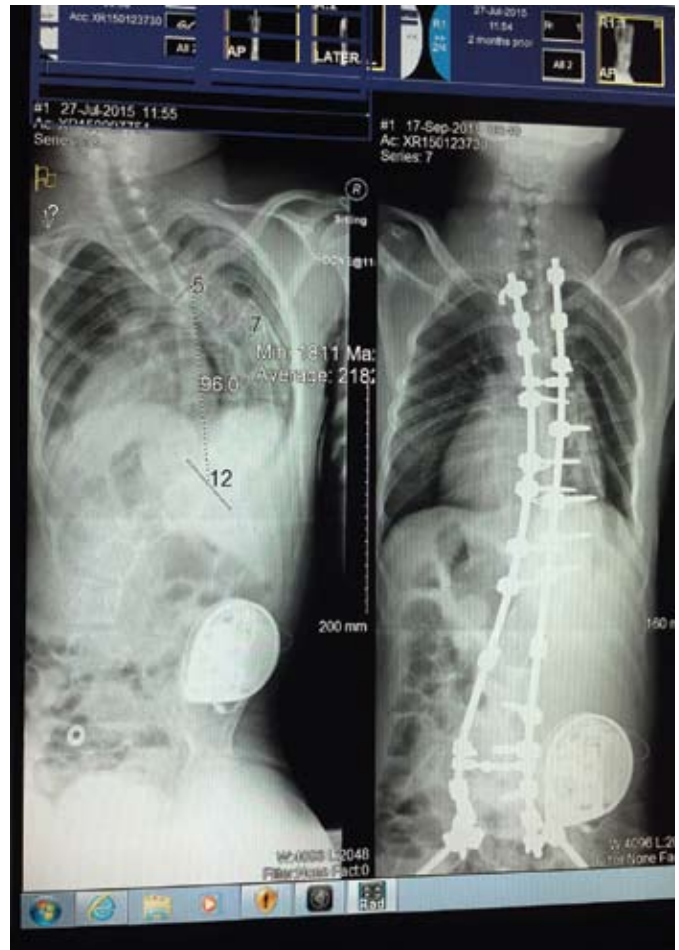

From The Potentate Bob Giesler

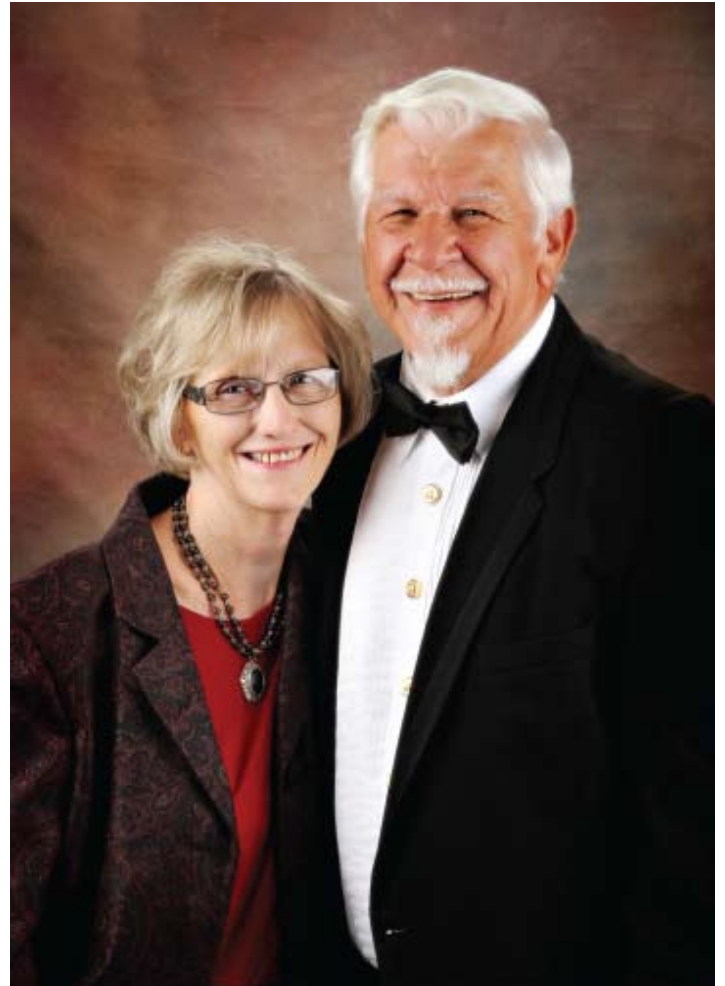
Did you notice how fast May went by?

From the moment you step inside his door, you are transported back in time to the days when the Ringling Bros and Barnum and Bailey Circuses toured the country. That was back when the circus traveled by rail and were the center of entertainment in the late 1800s and early 1900s.

For Richard, the museum is more than memorabilia of days gone by, but a living

showcase of a grand time in American life. Now Bennett, who never married, doesn't own a TV or a computer. He spends all of his time buying items for his extensive collection which has taken over this home including the kitchen, living room and several addition garages. He has kept everything and can quote dates and background on everything in his collection. Bennett has a marvelous memory for detail. Frank During marveled at Bennett's collection of honoring his father who served in WW1.

Richard is especially proud of two Cadillacs he once owned. One was owned by Marilyn Monroe, and a second one by Bette Davis.

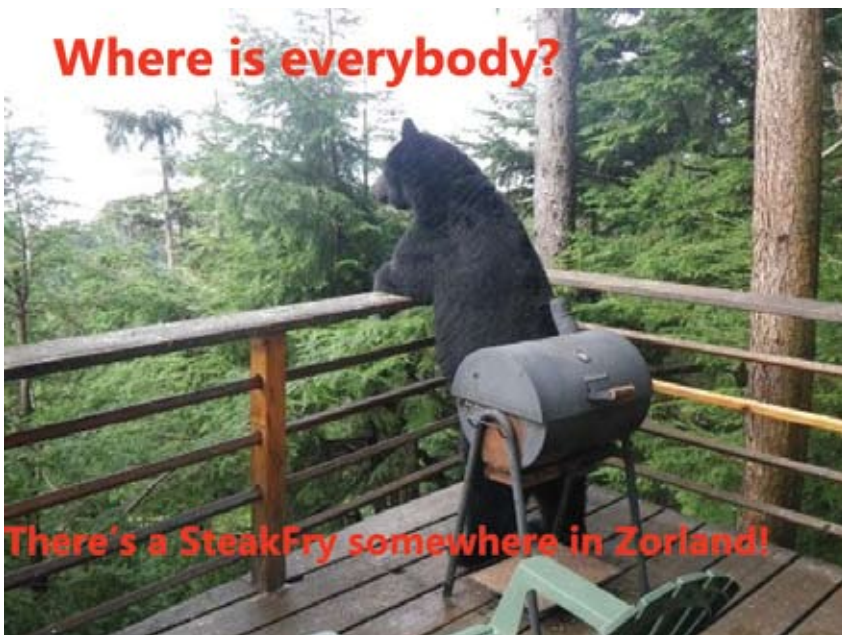
