## ZOR SHRINERS QUARTERLY MEETING MINUTES

OCTOBER 13 – MADISON James Stelsel, Sr – Recorder

The meeting was called to order by M. Steiber with 19 Nobles present at 3:47 P. M. K. Gant gave the opening prayer and all present joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

G. Cuskey moved approval of the agenda and seconded by J. Thorstad PP. Motion carried.

B. Ausen moved approval of the August 22 Quarterly meeting minutes and seconded by G. Cuskey. Motion Carried.

**Treasurers Report:** D. Olson reported on the 2015 budget item Promotion & Publicity of \$12,582.00, which pays for the printing and mailing the Zephyr to the Nobles. At the April 25, 2015 Quarterly meeting it was voted to send each Noble a printed copy of the Zephyr. We have also had to update Zor's Website which was not budgeted for. In order to cover the additional cost of the Zephyr and Website it is necessary to increase Promotion & Publicity Budget to \$25,000.00. D. Olson moved the Promotion & Publicity item money be taken from Zor's investment accounts and seconded by G. Cuskey. Motion Carried. J. Thorstad PP. moved the Promotion & Publicity item be increased to \$25,000.00 and seconded by W. Trounten. Motion Carried. D. Olson moved acceptance of the Treasurer's report ending September 30 and seconded by G. Cuskey. Motion Carried.

**Membership Report:** B. Hering reported ending September 30, 2015 we had 16 creations, 11 restorations, 51 deaths, 1 demit, 1 resignation, and 2 suspensions for a total loss of 28 Nobles leaving our total membership at 1434 including 13 associates. B. Hering moved acceptance of the report and seconded by D. Olson. Motion Carried.

J. Stelsel, Recorder, read the names of 19 departed Zor Nobles. K. Gant offered a prayer for the departed Nobles.

### COMMITTEE REPORTS:

**Trustees:** B. Jones reported rentals are down and catering issues seem to have subsided. B. Jones moved acceptance of the report and seconded by D. Holmen. Motion Carried.

**Circus Report:** J. Thorstad PP. reported that regarding the contract with Fun Time Shows, producer Bill Cunningham with the help of Attorney Mark Hazelbaker, the Divan, and Circus committee put together a contract termination agreement that was signed on September 22, 2015 by Bill Cunningham and myself. At the Imperial session some of the Divan met with Brett Carden and after several e-mails, phone calls and mailings, Carden Circus is offering to do Zor's 2016 circus. Carden has submitted a 8 page contract which has been reviewed by Attorney Hazelbaker and has rewritten a 10 page contract for Carden's review which is a one year contract for February 19, 20, & 21, 2016 at a cost of \$66,000.00. A one year contract for March 1 & 2 at La Crosse for a profit of \$3,750.00 is being considered. 2 weeks ago at the SCAFRA seminar in Bangor, Maine, Zor received 3rd place in the annual circus book program competition. Thorstad PP. moved acceptance of the report and seconded by D. Holmen. Motion Carried.

**Variety Shows:** S. Peterson PP. reported the fifth year for Variety/Magic Shows was a success for both Zor and the 13 clubs and units that sponsored the shows in 14 communities throughout Zorland. The net profit for the clubs and units was \$12,855.82 and the net profit for Zor was \$12,855.82 for a grand total of \$25,711.64. This was the second largest fundraiser for Zor. Thanks you to

the clubs and unit that sponsored the show. S. Peterson PP. moved acceptance of the report and seconded by J. Thorstad PP. Motion Carried.

**Calendar Sales:** B. Giesler reported we need a great effort to sell the calendars and any unsold calendars should be returned to the office for redistribution.

**Gun Raffle:** B. Giesler reported this year to insure we have the right guns we will be making a down payment on the guns. The drawing will be April 3, 2016.

**Hospital Reports:** M. Steiber reported no report was submitted for either Chicago or Twin Cities. Chicago will be celebrating their 90th year Gala on November 12.

### OLD BUSINESS:

**Hospital Van Replacements & Divers:** M. Stieber reported the drivers of the vans and those driving unit vehicles in the parades will need to renew the driver forms for insurance purposes for the next year.

**Zor Website:** B. Giesler reported the site is now on line but still needs some corrections. Training for the staff should be the end of this week or next week.

**Zephyr:** B. Giesler reported there is a coupon in the Zephyr, and will be in the Dues notice, to receive a printed copy of the Zephyr that is to be returned to the office if they wish to have a copy mailed to them in 2016. If the office does not receive the coupon, no Zephyr will be sent.

### NEW BUSINESS:

**December Ceremonial:** M. Steiber reported the Ceremonial will be at the Radisson Hotel in La Crosse the weekend of December 4th & 5th. The Rotary light walk will be outside the hotel. Ceremonial information will be in the Zephyr.

**Announcements:** D. Holmen reported on October 23, at 7:00 P.M. there will be a Masonic Family Reunion to renew old acquaintances and make new ones. Share information about your Masonic Order. Learn about other Masonic Orders and what they are doing. All are welcome.

D. Olson reported on the Sahara SC Raffle drawing on November 14th at the Town Inn Pizza restaurant in Jefferson at 12 noon and the UW Whitewater football game at 2:00 P. M.

K. Gant gave the closing prayer and the meeting was adjourned at 4:45 P.M.



## Official Notice of Zor 2016 Annual Meeting and Election of Officers

The official Notice of Zor's 2016 Annual Meeting and Election of Officers Zor Temple's Annual Meeting and election will be held Saturday, January 9, 2016 at the Zor Shriners Center in Madison. A total of 7 Zor officials will be elected and six members of the Appointive Divan named to posts during the election and post-election meeting and installation ceremony. This is the official notice required by Imperial Council:

### Election and Installation at Zor Temple on January 9, 2016

Notice is hereby given that the Annual Meeting for Zor Shrine will be held at the Zor Center on Saturday, January 9, 2016, beginning at 1 p.m. at which time annual reports will be presented, officers and representatives elected for the coming year, and such other business transacted as may properly come before the meeting.

#### ARTICLE 25, Section 325.4 to 325.6 of the Imperial Code reads as follows:

Each Temple must elect its officers and representatives by separate written ballot and by a majority vote of those present and voting. A blanket ballot is prohibited. Said election shall take place at the Temple's annual meeting in January of each year. Nominations must commence not later than 9 p.m. for an evening meeting or 3 p.m. for an afternoon meeting of the day on which the election is held, and when that hour arrives, all other business must immediately cease and not may be transacted until the election is concluded.

#### ARTICLE 25, Section 325.10(a)

The printing, publication, circulating or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets or other devices, by a Noble suggesting, recommending, opposing or containing the names of proposed candidates for office in the Temple, is prohibited (b) for any violation of section (a), the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending Noble and he may declare the election of said officers void and order a new election.
