



# CLARIFICATION: Annual Driver Certification form

There have been several questions and some confusion regarding the "Annual Driver Certification" form. I spoke with our insurance agent on May 14th to get clarification.

Our insurance carrier requires every Noble that drives a motorized vehicle representing or on behalf of the Shrine, submit an "Annual Driver Certification" form. This applies to hospital patient drivers as well as anyone driving a motorized vehicle in a parade such as mini-cars, scooters, motor cycles, 4-wheelers, vans, and etc. I realize that this is a change from past practices, and we could have done a better job of communicating this change to all clubs and units.

The reason for the questions regarding your own personal insurance is to prove insurability to Zor's carrier and to show that our drivers are responsible. Zor's insurance has primary coverage for any and all motorized Shrine vehicles and parade units on the road and in parades. The following quote is taken from an email from Zor's insurance agent; "The Shriners carry \$1,000,000 per occurrence for automobile related accidents. In addition to that coverage amount, they have purchased a \$2,000,000 liability umbrella. In essence, the Shriners and its units have \$3M of coverage for any one accident."

Another reason for the request for a driver's personal insurance is if a Noble is driving their own vehicle to a Shrine event or parade, their personal insurance would have primary coverage and Zor's insurance would be secondary. Per my discussion with Zor's insurance agent, we agreed that another question should be added to the form: "Do you carry auto insurance on your personal vehicle/s? With boxes to check: Yes or No." We will also drop the box asking for your physician's name, but leave the box to list the month and year of your most recent medical exam. I will ask our office staff to make the change on our Driver Certification Form, and forward to each club and unit.

Your personal insurance is, and has always been primary when going to or from a parade. During the parade, Zor's insurance will be primary even for parade vehicles that are owned by individual Nobles. Typically the secretary of each club or unit should list all vehicles owned or being used by the unit for parades when submitting their club/unit insurance form each year. Said forms are forwarded onto the insurance carrier as well as the Driver Certification Form.

Hopefully this letter helps clarify the need for "All" drivers of Shrine vehicles and parade units to submit a Driver Certification form in order to maintain compliance with our insurance carriers request and to ensure individual coverage for Shrine events. A Big Thank You to all Nobles for all that you do and for your support of Zor Shriners and our kids. 


