Zephyr Changes

Nobles all,

The Zephyr is, and has been, available to all "on-line" for over four (4) years.

The cost of printing and mailing a hard copy to you has put an enormous strain on the budget. Your current annual dues are \$70, of which \$20 must be remitted to Imperial. The annual cost of the Zephyr is over \$24 per noble...that is 48% of the \$50 retained by Zor!

Your Divan has always tried to be mindful of their responsibility to manage your Shrine in the best way possible, and with financial responsibility.

That said, it was decided at the September Divan meeting, that as of January 1, 2015, to continue receiving the hard copy version of the Zephyr, you need to add \$25 with your 2015 dues payment. If you wish to pay by credit card, please add \$25 (for a total of \$95) to the authorization on the back of the dues notice.

Widows of Nobles will continue to receive the hard copy.

An email notice that the newest issue of the Zephyr is available, with a link to it, will be sent to all email addresses on file. If your email address changes, please be sure to inform Zor of the change!

There has been a bit of concern over the recent change to the Zephyr subscriptions. In part, it is a fact that not everyone may have a computer, and thus feel partially cut off from communication.

If you do not have a computer and do not wish to pay the additional \$25 per year to receive a hard copy, there are several alternatives. Most public libraries have computers available, someone in your family or circle of friends (and certainly any other Noble) may have a computer to use or print a copy off of. It will be smaller in size than the hard copy edition, and may or may not be in color, but it is an option.

Your Divan struggled with the subscription decision for many months. It was the most viable solution to the situation that could be developed.

2015 Circus Dates Announced

Due to a circus scheduling conflict, Fun Times Show (George Carden Circus) will be in Madison the 2nd weekend and not the 3rd weekend, as in years past. So mark your calendars for February 13, 14, and 15 2015. The show times will stay the same - Friday -7:00 p.m.; Saturday - 10:00 a.m., 2:30 p.m., and 7:00 p.m.; and Sunday -1:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m.

Tickets will be mailed on December 12th, plenty of time to give/sell to family, neighbors, or co-workers - they also make great Christmas gifts. Ticket prices remain the same as last year - a sheet of 6 tickets

has a face value of \$102.00 but you only pay \$70.00 and that will get your name added to the 2015 Ringmaster's Club that is printed in the April Zephyr. Reserved seat tickets are now available at the circus office. As was done last year, we ask you to return your paid and unused tickets, which will be forwarded to the Wisconsin Air National Guard.

This has always been Zor's largest fund raiser and helps keep Zor Shrine operational. We need 100 % participation from all clubs and units. We have already received 8 bicycle donations, we need 10 more commitments of \$100.00 to fill our 18 bicycle goal as we have done in years past. Any unit that wants to submit a new picture for the program should

submit it to the office by January 10th. We also are in need of a Shriner to highlight in the program for outstanding service to the Madison shows over the years.

Circus Chairman John Thorstad has had several phone conversations with George Carden, who will be in Madison the entire weekend. A all new show with returning award winning The Chicago Boyz, David Smith - The Human Cannonball, a new ringmaster, new clown act, and more animals.

The La Crosse Circus date has also changed: two shows on Wednesday March 4th at 4:15 p.m. and 7:15 p.m.



Official Notice of Zor 2015 Annual Meeting and Election of Officers

The official Notice of Zor's 2015 Annual Meeting and Election of Officers Zor Temple's Annual Meeting and election will be held Saturday, January 10, 2015 at the Zor Shriners Center in Madison. A total of 7 Zor officials will be elected and six members of the Appointive Divan named to posts during the election and post-election meeting and installation ceremony. This is the official notice required by Imperial Council:

Election and Installation at Zor Temple on January 10, 2015

Notice is hereby given that the Annual Meeting for Zor Shrine will be held at the Zor Center on Saturday, January 10, 2015, beginning at 1 p.m. at which time annual reports will be presented, officers and representatives elected for the coming year, and such other business transacted as may properly come before the meeting.

ARTICLE 25, Section 325.4 to 325.6 of the Imperial Code reads as follows:

Each Temple must elect its officers and representatives by separate written ballot and by a majority vote of those present and voting. A blanket ballot is prohibited. Said election shall take place at the Temple's annual meeting in January of each year. Nominations must commence not later than 9 p.m. for an evening meeting or 3 p.m. for an afternoon meeting of the day on which the election is held, and when that hour arrives, all other business must immediately cease and not may be transacted until the election is concluded.

ARTICLE 25, Section 325.10(a)

The printing, publication, circulating or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets or other devices, by a Noble suggesting, recommending, opposing or containing the names of proposed candidates for office in the Temple, is prohibited (b) for any violation of section (a), the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending Noble and he may declare the election of said officers void and order a new election.
