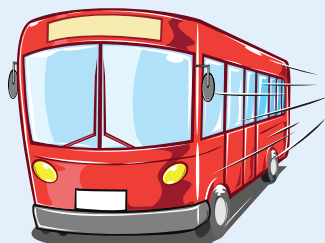

I first talked with Jean on July 6, 2010. An 87-year-old, retired Michigan attorney, he had called to talk about our Charitable Gift Annuity program. A local college, to which he had often donated, had approached him about a CGA, but he had heard about our hospital and wanted an alternative gift option. After several conversations and a couple of mailings, he chose us, and I linked him with our Tampa office for necessary calculations. Jean and I had many conversations throughout the fall, and on August 13, 2010, he purchased a \$1 million CGA for himself and his wife. A month or so later, he bought a second, \$500,000 CGA, for his four children. We continued to communicate by phone and letter following the transactions—I, sending articles and books he might enjoy; he, responding by letter and phone with thanks and conversations.

In a routine call to Jean this month, I was informed that his phone had been disconnected. Concerned, I wrote him immediately, inquiring of his well-being and thanking him for his generosity. A week later, he called, his voice weak, saying, "I'm not good—I'm terminal—I'm on my way out. But I feel good about Shriners, and I thank you. You're in our will. I just wanted to thank you, and tell you goodbye. I'm so weak I must hang up."

"Your call means so much to me," I replied, "Thank you, and God bless. . . ."

"Thank you," he said, and the phone clicked.

Philanthropy is a remarkable idea. It originates from the Latin, philo – to love, and anthropos – mankind. It illumines in all directions with brilliance and abundant life, touching those served and those serving, radiating kindness among people. Properly understood, philanthropy brightens all that is human—humane—in the social life of a nation. Jean's final call was a beautiful testimony to this principle.

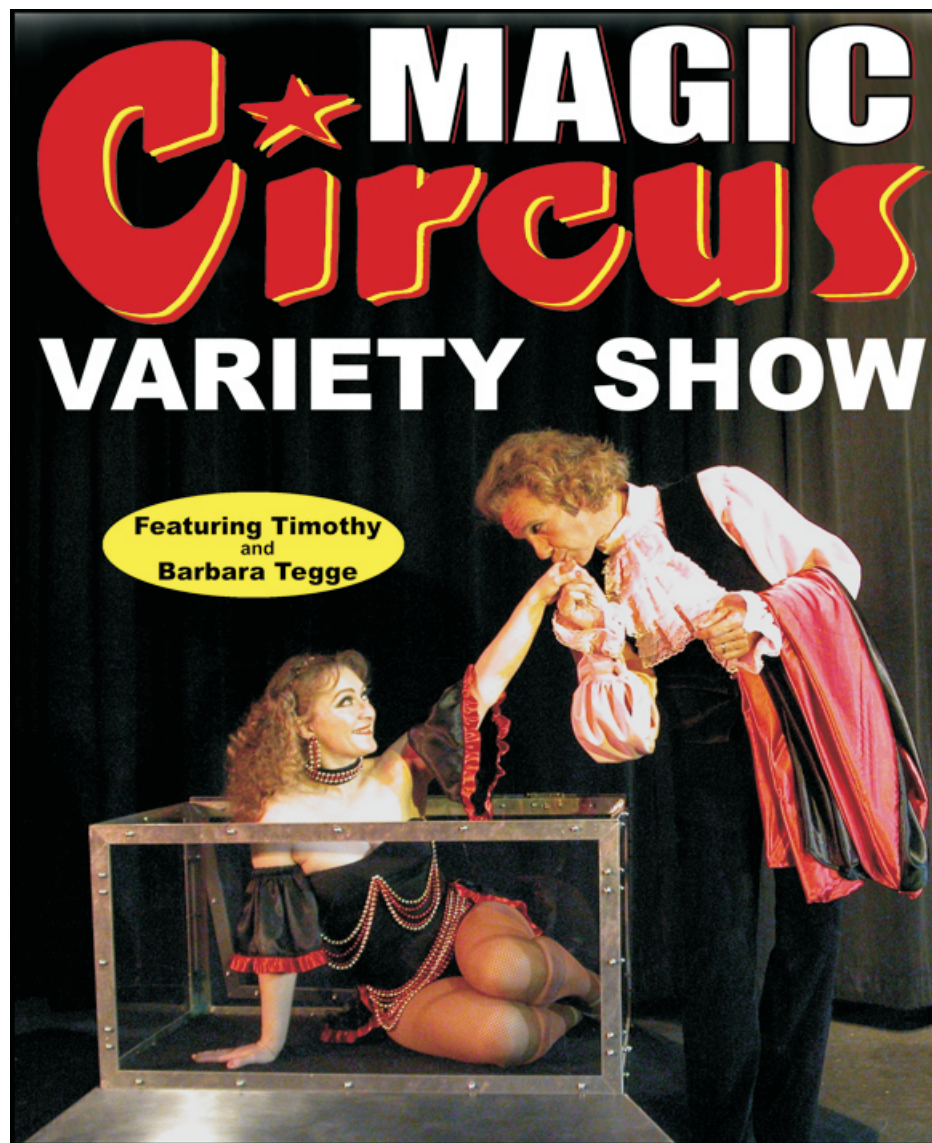

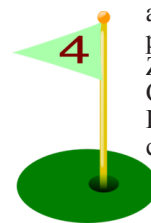
honorary pitches. After the game, stay for the fireworks and receive a free ice cream scoop on your way out of the park.

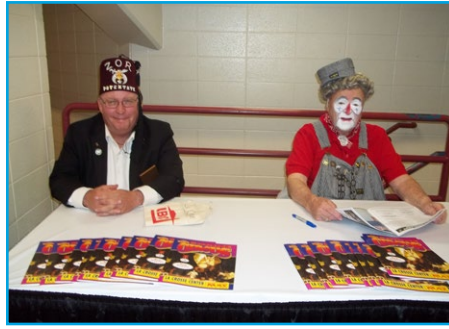
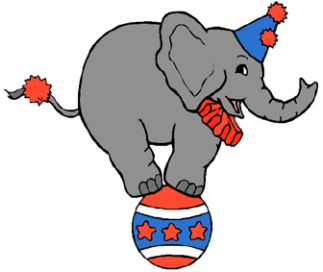

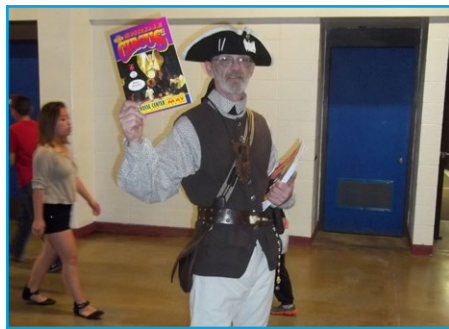

In July 1987, Bob was blessed with a second loving marriage to Loeta Reed. They enjoyed 24 years of travel and antiquing, before Loeta's death in 2011.

Illustrious Sir W. Robert Cress PP, 89, died Saturday April 19, at Rest Haven Health Care Center surrounded by his loving family. He was born August 18, 1924 in Boyd, MN, the only son of Dr. Earl Elliott & Ola Mae Cress. In April 1943, he entered the Army Air Corp Medical Unit as a surgical nurse. While stationed at the Plattsburgh Air Force Base in Plattsburgh, NY he met Hazel M. Martel. Their shared love of dancing brought them together and the rest is history. They were married in August, 1945 and happily celebrated their 38th wedding anniversary before Hazel's death in 1983.



After the service, Bob enrolled in Worsham College of Mortuary Science in Chicago, where he graduated in 1948. He worked as a funeral director at an Eau Claire funeral home before pursuing his long term plan to purchase his own funeral home. In 1977, Bob and Hazel purchased the Frautschi Funeral Home in Madison, expanding the organization to what it is today: The Cress Funeral & Cremation Service, serving Dane County with Bob's personal commitment; "Service is Love & Concern in Action". He was a licensed funeral director for over 66 years.

Bob was the first president of the Sun Prairie Rotary Club, a Past Master of Sanctuary Lodge #347 in Eau Claire,
