Zor Shriners will hold its only 2014 Ceremonial December 6th at the Chula Vista Resort & Waterpark in Wisconsin Dells, WI. The Ceremonial is open to Zor Shriners, their ladies and guests. The Ceremonial is also a fantastic opportunity to bring Master Masons who are not members into our fraternity of the Ancient Arabic Order of the Nobles of the Mystic Shrine. The Ceremonial offers the opportunity to renew acquaintances and make new friendships.

THE VENUE: CHULA VISTA RESORT & WATERPARK

After a year away, Zor Shriners return to the Chula Vista Resort and Waterpark, located on the east side of Wisconsin Dells approximately 2.8 miles north of Downtown Wisconsin Dells on Hwy 13 North. The Standard Room in the North Tower section of the Hotel is \$95/night (plus taxes & fees). Chula Vista also has other room options to accommodate your needs. The deadline for reserving rooms is November 15. After November 15, reservations will be provided on a space available basis at rates published by Chula Vista & subject to availability. All Standard Rooms will be reserved in the North Tower section of the Resort to minimize the amount of walking distance to the Ceremonial's activities.

THE CEREMONIAL – FRIDAY DECEMBER 5

The Ceremonial has a number of events and activities for everyone to enjoy.

On Friday evening, Zor will welcome its travelers with a Hospitality Room so that everyone has a chance to refresh and recharge with beverages and snacks and to meet and socialize with other Ceremonial attendees. This is also a great time to meet candidates & their ladies.

There is no formal, organized dinner on Friday evening for the Ceremonial participants. This provides the opportunity to explore the many and varied culinary delights of Wisconsin Dells. THE CEREMONIAL – SATURDAY DECEMBER 6

The Ceremonial kicks off on Saturday morning at 7 am with member and candidate registration in the hallway outside of the side entrance to the Convention Rooms. Adjacent to the Registration area, the Daughters of the Nile will be selling cookies and crafts, the Veteran's Patrol Unit will be selling Zor Shriners and other Masonic regalia, the Ladies Auxiliary will also have a booth of goodies and the Youth Groups will have informational booths on their respective organizations.

At 9 am, the Candidates and their ladies will attend an Orientation Session to give them a brief overview of the Shrine Organization in general as well as Zor Shriners in particular. This educational session is also open to all Ceremonial participants.

Following the Orientation Session, the Ceremonial will be officially opened by the Zor Shriners Divan under the direction of Potentate Larry Hanson. This is the 1st section of the Ceremonial and is open to all Ceremonial guests. Following the Opening Ceremony, Zor's Ritual Divan will present the 3rd Section in full Arabic Costume. The 3rd Section is open to all Ceremonial participants up to the point of the Candidate obligation, at which time those other than Zor Shriners must retire.

Upon completion of the 3rd Section, the men and women will participate in respective lunches. Lunch for the ladies (including candidates' ladies) will be served in the South Riverview Room in the lower level atrium of Chula Vista's Convention Center. This year's theme will be focused on fun and festivities associated with the upcoming Holiday Season. Lunch for the men and candidates will be served in the Upper Dells Ballroom. Lunch menus for both the ladies and men will be a buffet style with soups, salad, deli style meats and assorted deserts.

Cost for either the ladies or men's lunch is \$17 and must be reserved by November 15. Any reservation received after that date will be assessed a \$20 per person late fee. No reservations will be accepted after November 22. ***No meal tickets will be sold at Ceremonial.*** Please complete and return the Ceremonial Meal Reservation Form in this issue of the Zor Zephyr.

After lunch, all Nobles and their ladies are welcome to attend the presentation of the Arch Degree. This special ceremony provides further insight and education regarding the relationship of the Zor Shriners within the Masonic Fraternity. This will be the first time Zor Shriners has "conferred" the Arch Degree and should be a very impressive and moving experience.

Following the Arch Degree, Potentate Larry Hanson will preside over the remainder of the afternoon's Ceremonial activities, including introductions of VIPs, the FEZ Ceremony, Awards and Recognitions, and the Traditional Parade to Glory.

From 5-6 pm, a Social/Fellowship hour will take place in the main room of the Convention Center, after which will be the Ceremonial Banquet from 6-8 pm. The menu will consist of Prosciutto-wrapped Pork Tenderloin, salad, mashed potatoes, corn, rolls, beverage and desert.

Cost for the Ceremonial Banquet is \$35 and must be reserved by November 15. Any reservation received after that
