The Ceremonial kicks off on Saturday morning at 7 am with member and candidate registration in the hallway outside of the side entrance to the Convention Rooms. Adjacent to the Registration area, the Daughters of the Nile will be selling cookies and crafts, the Veteran's Patrol Unit will be selling Zor Shriners and other Masonic regalia, the Ladies Auxiliary will also have a booth of goodies and the Youth Groups will have informational booths on

their respective organizations.





AWARD OF MERIT RUL

No member of the Zor Divan or past member of the Divan will be eligible for consideration until at least five years following his being on the Divan. Then only for Voluntary Service that is within Zor's sphere of influence.

To nominate your candidate, please provide a nomination letter describing why you feel this Noble is deserving of this award, i.e., what activities he has participated in, what offices has he held with the club/unit, how has he contributed to the shrine philanthropy, how has he been involved with helping children, etc.


