EVERY SPINE HAS A STORY

Emily, 7, From Central Illinois, Doesn't Let Scoliosis Slow Her Down

Emily poses with her many casts she wore from age 15 months to 4 to treat infantile scoliosis (an abnormal spine curve in children diagnosed before age 3). Shriners Children's pediatric orthopedic spine surgeons specialize in the application of these Mehta Cotrel casts. During casting, pressure is placed on the cast, causing the spine to straighten. Each cast is worn for two to three months, with a brief break between.



Emily was referred to the pediatric spine team at Shriners Chicago by her pediatrician for a left side curve in her back. She now wears a brace as part of scoliosis treatment. Her favorite part of the Chicago hospital is quote "playing on the playgrounds outside and inside."

A ROLLING THUNDER OF FUN

Vesper Days Parade Shows Shriner Spirit

Almost 200 Shriners from 16 units converged on Vesper, Wisconsin, to prove that the opportunity to give fun while having fun remains a potent rallying force for our Fraternity.

Presided over by the Most Worshipful Grand Master of Masons of Wisconsin Joseph Thompson, the Shrine contingent fielded wave after wave of trucks, mini cars, clowns, mini fire engines, frighteningly souped-up lawnmower-based mini trucks, and more.

Potentate Steve Livernash, Assistant Rabban Mike Kastens, and Petey the Parrot had the honor of driving MWGM Thompson and the First Lady Julie in the fabulous 1872 Shrine Time Machine. These honorable gentlemen rode the infernal contraption right along the seam of the space-time continuum to unleash a radiating storm of hilarity and joy – and a trail of smoke-filled bubbles.

The Parade included clowns from Zor Funsters, Zor Shrine Clowns, Sawdusters, and Firehouse Jesters who, despite steamy weather, donned heavy makeup and costumes, tromping their way down the main streets of Vesper in their silly floppy shows.

The Zor Midgets, Mavericks, Mini Cars and the “Fearless” Tin Lizzies zipped through formations and near collisions in a series of devil-may-care maneuvers which delighted children and thrilled the souls of everyone lining the parade route.

The Visioneers’ stampeded through town with their mighty, mounted fire-breathing bull, barely contained in a sound machine trailer, towed with great care to avoid a threat to life or limb of the assembled throngs. DJ Marty Brown spinning and squealing his 428 Cobra Jet mini-Thunderbird entertained young and old.

It is safe to say that no event since the founding of the Village of Vesper in 1948 has thrilled children, fascinated babies, inspired adolescents,

and amused adults. Many stopped looking at their smartphones as Zor units went by, a sign of the great power of Shrine entertainers.

And to accentuate the Shrine presentation with evidence of its pervasive presence in our nation, a semi tractor pulled a full-size trailer with advertising for the great Children's Hospitals charity of the Shrine.

These Shriners, several past Potentates among them, traipsed boldly through the town, at the end of the designated parade route coming together at Cameron Park. There, the Masonic horde parked their mini cars and vehicles, loosened collars, and began the second part of the event – fraternal fun.

Being a Shriner is definitely about giving. Our charities are a billion-dollar operation bringing hope to children in need from coast to coast and in Mexico City. But there's a reward for these efforts – connections with others who share the spirit of giving.

In that spirit, MWGM Thompson stayed around for several hours to greet the Shriners who made the journey. Potentate Livernash greeted many Vesperians fascinated by the Time Machine and the Shrine.

We are very grateful for the brethren of Wisconsin Rapids Lodge 128, who cooked hundreds of burgers, brats, and dogs and sold them with chips and soda to a huge wave of Shrine customers who had managed to work up quite an appetite.

What We Learned...

Vesper represented our potential for showing communities what the Shrine stands for – the fun and silliness, but also the power that the love of Masons for their communities can have. By summoning the Shrine community to this grand parade in Vesper, Potentate Livernash set a template for how we must carry our message. We need more such mass parades! The fun is waiting for us.

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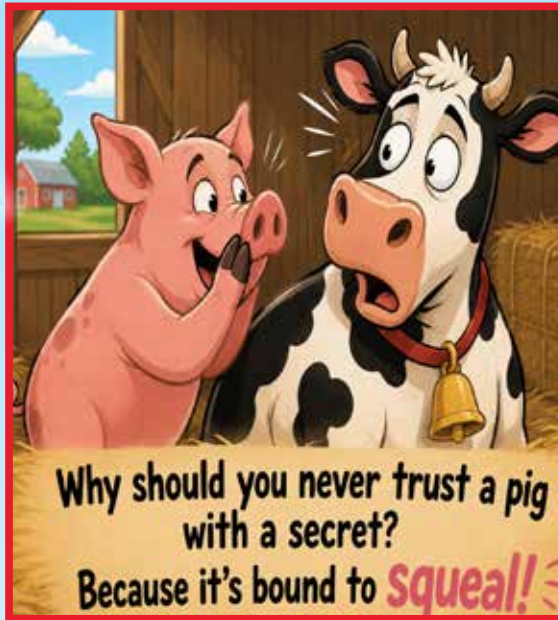

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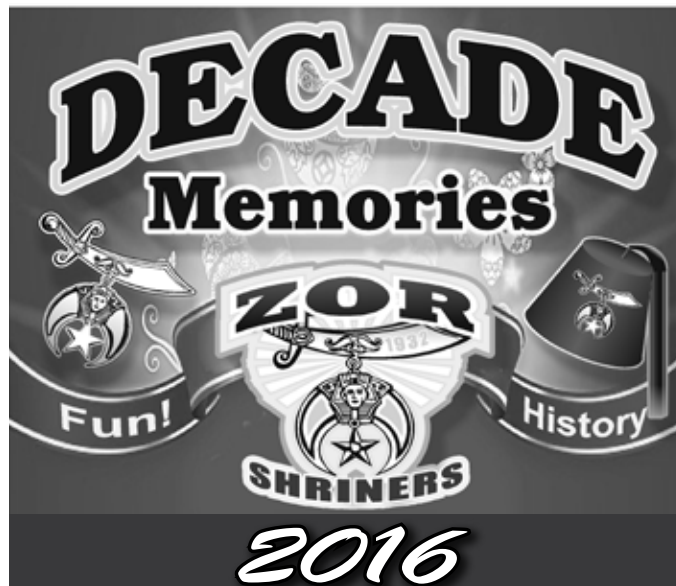
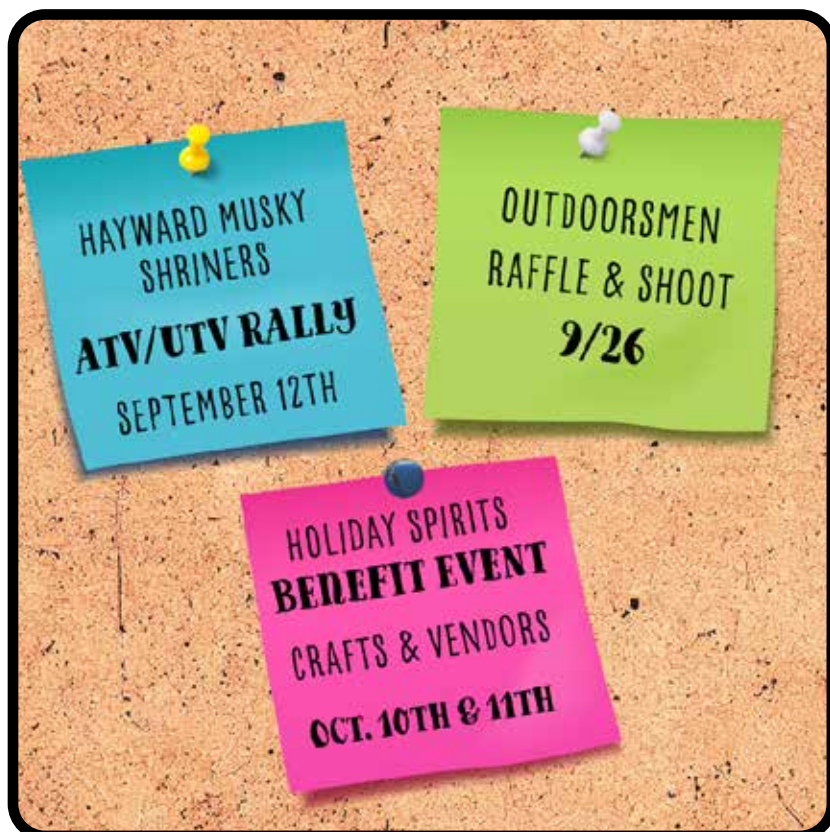
