WORKING FOR THE FUTURE

7th Annual State of Science Conference helps bridge research, engineering, technology and healthcare

The 7th annual State of Science research conference developed by Shriners Children's Chicago returned to the hospital February 28 through March 1.

The Ballreich Patient Activity Mall hosted more than 130 physicians, clinicians, data scientists, engineers and researchers. More than 30 presentations covered topics in muscle and bone health, including early research into a compound that could lead to the first oral treatment for osteogenesis imperfecta. Other presentations explored the muscle response in children missing part of one arm, which scientists may use to develop even better prosthetics.



Several Chicago physicians presented, including Dr. Altiok, who shared his early work in partnership with Georgia Tech on using AI to identify and treat Legg-Calvé-Perthes disease at earlier stages.

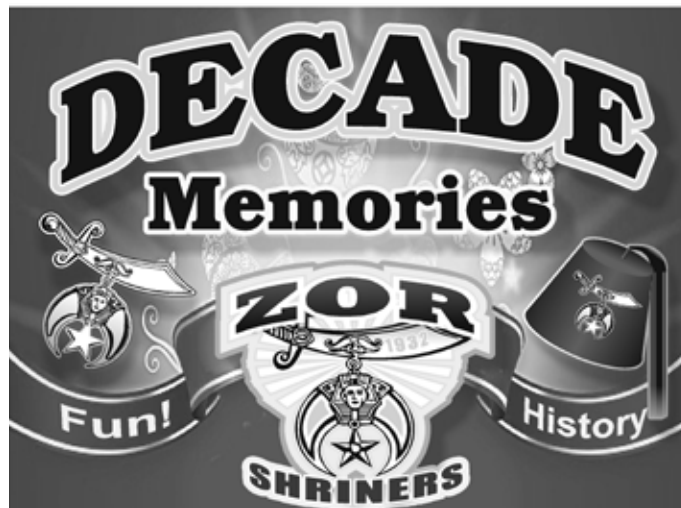
