Shriners Children's is making it easier for patients to receive the best care possible with our new orthopedic outreach clinic in Champaign-Urbana, IL.

Doctors from Shriners Children's St. Louis and Chicago are able to provide pediatric orthopedic care to both new and existing patients. The clinic, held 4 times a year, is located at Carle at The Fields in Champaign.

Patients have access to care, including follow-up visits after surgery, routine check-ups, and consultations for those referred to a specialist, but who don't have access to a pediatric orthopedic surgeon in their community. Our new ortho clinic in Champaign does not treat fractures or sports injuries.

NOTICE FROM SHRIN

Beginning August 2025, all Nobles whose dues are paid for the 2026 temple year will receive a newly issued and attractive membership card featuring a refreshed design and enhanced functionality. We hope this card inspires the pride every Shriner should feel as part of an exclusive Masonic group. These updates are part of our ongoing commitment to improving Shriners membership experience and ensuring secure, and convenient access to Shrine-related services.

What's Changing

- New Card Design: The design will align with the digital membership card for a consistent experience across all Shrine formats. The updated cards will include a QR code on the back, enabling quick and secure verification of membership status and event participation.
- Shrine ID Number: In alignment with our ongoing modernization efforts, only the Shrine ID number will appear on membership cards. This unique identifier, assigned to each Noble, remains with him throughout his Shrine membership, even if he transfers to another temple, and supports streamlined recordkeeping across all Shrine Temples.
- Expanded Use of QR Codes: The new cards will no longer display the membership year. Temples will verify a Noble's dues paid status by scanning the QR code on the card for accurate and current membership status. This applies also to digital cards via the My FezCardViewer.

• Associate Memberships: Associate membership cards have been discontinued. To verify a Noble's good standing at all Shrine meetings and events, temples must now scan the Noble's QR code located on the back of their membership card.

These changes are part of our broader digital transformation initiative, aimed at enhancing security, simplifying verification, and streamlining member identification.

Key Updates

- Gold Card Discontinuation: Effective July 7, 2025, gold cards will no longer be processed or replaced.
- Address Verification: All mailing addresses will be validated through the National Change of Address (NCOA) system. Any flagged addresses will be forwarded to Temple leadership for follow-up and update to WebFez.

Action Required

To ensure a smooth rollout and minimize returned mail and associated costs, we strongly encourage you to:

- Review and update member records promptly.
- Contact affected members directly to confirm or correct mailing information.
- Run the Bad Address report for contact list of those Nobles with a flagged bad address. Questions related to this process can be directed to Fraternal Information Services at webfezfeedback@shrinenet.org.



Scoliosis Won't Slow Madison Down this Summer

The Pediatric Orthotic and Prosthetic Services team keeps her on the move.

In honor of National Scoliosis Month, Shriners Children's Florida ambassador Madison proudly shows off artwork she made to help spread the word about her diagnosis.

"I love butterflies, so both pictures have butterflies with curves – just like me," she said. "And the messages of Crooked Wings Still Learn to Fly and Curved but Not Broken are supposed to help encourage other patients going through similar experiences as me."

In the United States, 2% to 5% of children develop scoliosis, where the spine curves to make a C shape or S shape, rather than growing in a straight line. For Madison, her curve was detected during a routine scoliosis screening when she was 12. Shortly thereafter, she became a new patient of Shriners Children's Pediatric Orthotic and Prosthetic Services (POPS) in Tampa.

"They are so amazing and caring here," said Aimee, Madison's mother. "You feel like family from the moment you walk in. Plus, you're never rushed! They listen to concerns from parent and child."

Since becoming a patient, Madison has received two custom scoliosis jackets to help slow the onset and progression of her curve. Her current care plan requires her to wear her brace 18 hours a day, so the team in POPS works closely with her to ensure the best overall look, feel, fit and function of her device.

I'll admit, I was nervous about wearing the brace. I was worried I wouldn't be able to do everyday things – but I was wrong.

From 4-H to Girl Scouts, the soon-to-be seventh grader keeps a busy schedule. After nine years in the program, she has earned the title of cadet, serves on the Girl Scout committee and is a camp counselor in training. She also loves all things arts and crafts, especially sewing and resin. Her show cow's name is Pickles, she has a dog named Toby, and she also has three cats: Juliet, Faith and Hope. When she's not busy juggling her hobbies, she's an all-star babysitter and a proud big sister.

"We are always on the go, trying something new or traveling to new places," Aimee said. "Truly, never a dull moment! So, there is so much comfort in knowing we have a community here to help support her."
