Zor Shriners, for many years, has underwritten some of each unit member's expenses to attend and participate in the Midwest Shrine Association's Summer Session. The way these expenses were credited to the members was through a hotel room cost adjustment before the session and a refund to the member's unit following the session for those members who attended and participated.

This year a new online MSA registration system is being utilized. What that means is that each attending member must register online and then work through his unit leadership to obtain a hotel room reservation.

Historically, Zor has refunded to the participating unit, half of the unit member's registration fee and a mileage allowance based upon the unit's home base. Again this was historically done following the session. This year we will be making this registration adjustment at the time the member registers. 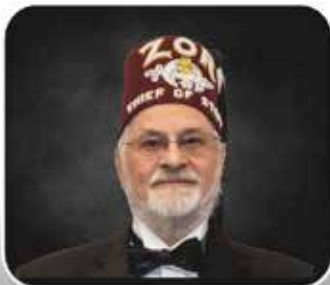

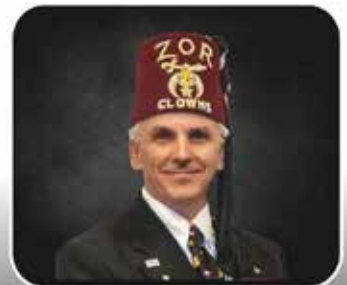

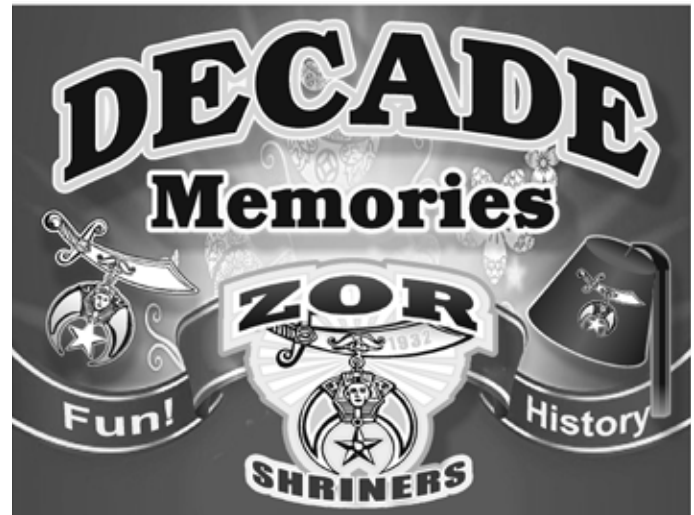
