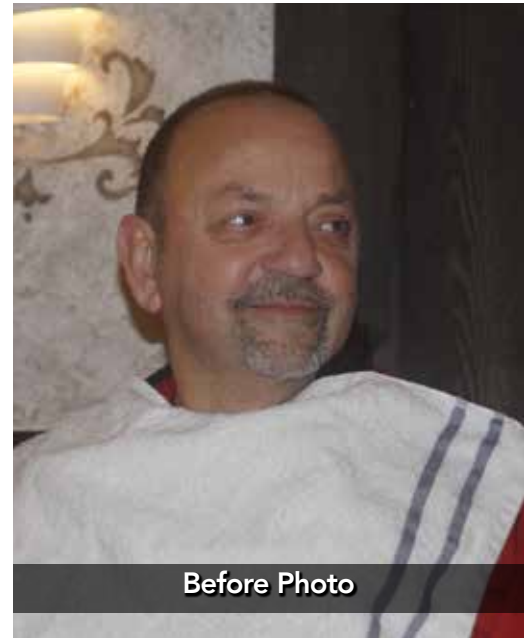


Making of a Clown

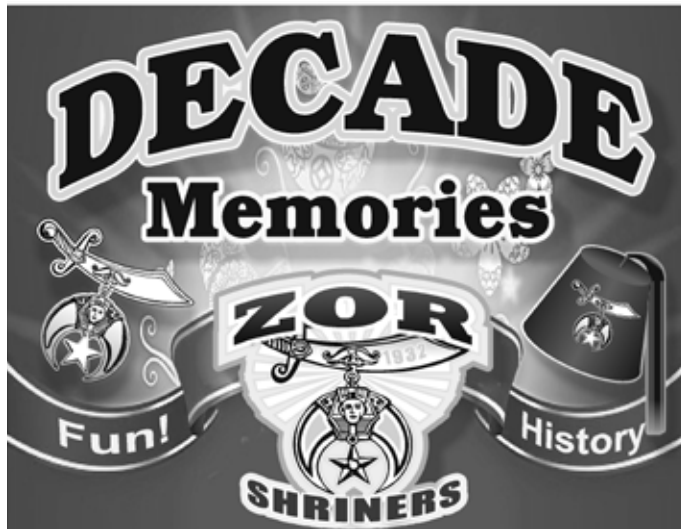
