



Born October 12, 1944. A neighbor lady asked Karl's brother, Jerry, what his parents would name him. He replied, "'Christopher,' I suppose."

Karl has lived his entire life on the farm, part of which has been in the family since 1888, raising beef cattle and hogs. He lived in the same house all his life until trading homes with Grand Nephew, Austin and family, in December, 2020. He's now living on an adjoining farm purchased in 1968.

He was a charter member of DeMolay in Monroe and served as Deputy State Master Counsilor for 6 months in 1965.

He became a Master Mason in Argyle Lodge on January 13, 1966 and served as WM in 1970, 1977, and 1978 and Secretary since 2011. He has hosted several open air degrees on the farm in the past 30 years. He started conducting Masonic funeral services in 1974 and has conducted 189 services in the past 48 years. Karl joined Zor Shrine on December 7, 1968 following receiving the York Rite degrees. He probably attended 4 Shrine events in his first 40 years of membership before becoming Chaplain in 2009. He is president of the Mound View Shrine Club.

Over the years he has been active with Jaycees, Southwestern Wisconsin Beef Cattle Co-op. (a feeder cattle sales organization), Blanchardville United Methodist Church (lay speaker and 53 years as Treasurer), madrigals, Lafayette County Dairy Sales, Inc. (a food stand promoting dairy products at Yellowstone Lake), Blanchardville Historical Society, and internet ministry. He bowled for 35 years until the bowling alley closed. He has hunted deer since 1980. He enjoyed viewing them before that, but 100 deer in 1 field necessitated his assistance in thinning the herd in the neighborhood.

Karl is semi-retired now (2 nephews and 1 grand nephew operate the farm) but still caught and treated over 100 beef calves at birth this year and wages an eternal war on brush that he will never win.

His parents passed away in 1994 and both siblings in 2012. He has 41 nieces and nephews and grand and great great nieces and nephews.
