1. 2026 ARRL Foundation Scholarship Program is Now Accepting Applications

- i. 10/30/2025 -Applications will be accepted through December 30, 2025, at 12 PM EST.
- ii. Students are encouraged to apply for more than 170 scholarships ranging from \$500 to \$25,000. All applicants must be active, FCC-licensed amateur radio operators.
- iii. The scholarships were established by generous donors and are managed by the ARRL Foundation as a means to inspire youth to explore amateur radio and to pursue higher education and related career paths -- and especially in wireless communications.
