Oxford County ARES/CERT Comm February 2024 Newsletter

Greetings and Happy New Year everyone! I hope everyone had some time to spend with your families during the holidays. This newsletter had started out as the January edition and finally emerged as the February edition. Speaking of February we have our 7:00 PM monthly meeting Monday February 5th in South Paris with a pre-meeting at Applebee's in Oxford at 5:00 PM EST. We had our first 2024 successful meeting January 8th with John WQ1W, Brian W1BKW, Dan N1XYL, Norm KA1SG, our state ARES EC Keith KE4UCW, and Wayne N1YIS attending. The mixed in-person and ZOOM meeting style has been working. The in-person 5:00pm premeeting dinner at Applebee's gave some of us a chance to catchup on happenings in our lives.

Keith KE4UCW had some notes for us about the upcoming WinLink presentations and Region 1 FEMA goals of implementing WinLink as the radio version of email. There was a brief discussion about the implementing SHARES which I will have a brief article in the next newsletter explaining what it is.

This coming year I have set some goals to be finished by Field Day 2024. They are:

- 1. Finish the EMA radio room
- 2. Have the group proficient in using WinLink
- 3. Test six different bands to discover the viability of the use of each band for simplex communications in our county
- **4.** Review the newer 2019 CERT manual focusing on the communications section.

- 5. Find, check and update each of the deployed VHF radios at fire/EMS departments and health services departments (Hospitals and clinics.).
- 6. Acquire and setup a Fusion and DMR radio at the EMA that will reach 'local' repeaters.
- 7. Have an amateur radio testing session in this county for the people who have either been studying or have the books to test and receive their licenses.
- 8. Complete an updated inventory of our equipment at the EMA and in the Communication Trailer.

These goals I have listed are not in any specific order.

At the BOAT Anchor Hamfest in Augusta on February 10th I hope to gather support and personnel to have a test session here in Oxford County this spring. Some books have been in the hands of potential hams for a year. It would be good to have these folks licensed and on the air.

Countywide Testing Six Different Bands

In the upcoming months, we will be testing six different bands after a regularly scheduled Oxford County ARES/CERT Comm net on Monday nights.

160 Meter Test

The first test will be February 12, 2024 for Phone (voice) on 160 meters at or around 1935 khz (Lower Side Band). This should be a good winter frequency for night communications. I will be contacting members of the group who are typically unable to meet with us on Mondays to schedule a second test in later in the month of February on a different week night. The tests will probably run ten to fifteen minutes at most, so if you have the equipment please join us. Also please note CQ 160 meter contest date for

2 Meter FM Simplex Tests

The second test will be after the February 19, 2024 net for Phone (voice) on 2 meters on the 146.550 Mhz to be followed on our secondary frequency 147.435 Mhz. We may use a digital mode from the Fldigi

suite, so please dust that off and check connections before the net that night.

ALSO If you haven't used the brief messaging feature in APRS either in a long time or ever please review that feature. I would like to test that system at the conclusion of our meeting in February. Someone will be generating a message over the system from the EMA and a response back will give us as a group this messaging system capabilities.

10 & 6 Meter Test

The next test will be February 26, 2024 following the regularly scheduled net. Currently I am looking at 28.375 Mhz (+or – 5khz) USB and 51.20 Mhz (+or – 5khz)USB & 52.54 FM (Simplex Calling).

40 and 60 Meter Test

The final test will be for 40 meters at 7.262 (and the frequency is subject to change depending on time of day and foreign broadcasters on frequency.) The 60 meter test will be on voice channel 2 (5.3465 Mhz USB) with a backup of channel 3 (5.3570 Mhz USB)

Also mark your calendar: Major Change At NearFest


-NEAR-Fest XXXV, will be held FOR TWO FULL DAYS, on Thursday April 25th and Friday April 26th 2024.
