

## 2026 Recital Costume Sheet: Thursday Classes

### **Hair**

- Hair pulled back into a low bun with a center part
  - To make the center part, brush all of the dancer's hair back away from their face, find the middle of the dancer's nose, and take the end of a comb/finger tip and make a clean, straight line down the center of the dancer's head
- Hair must be slicked back neatly away from the face, using hair gel and hair spray
- Low bun must be secured with hair elastics, hair pins, bobby pins, and a hair net that matches the dancer's hair color

### **Hair Materials**

- Hair elastics that match the dancer's hair color

    - [Example for dancers with very thick hair](#) (we suggest placing a regular hair elastic in first and then following up with this extra long hair elastic to secure dancer's hair)
- Hair pins (highly suggested, especially for dancers with long and/or thick hair) - please match dancer's hair color

    - Note - Different lengths of pins available; choose the length that makes the most sense for your dancer depending on the thickness and length of their hair!
- Hair net (sold at Capezio in Wellesley if you need more) - please match the dancer's hair color

- Pink Dress Costume

  - Rhinestone Clip:
- Pinned to the right side of the bun

- Pink Jumpsuit Costume
- Tan Tights
- Black Hip Hop Shoes, no-show low socks

  - 1 hair tie:
- Wrapped around the top of the bun



### Grade 5-6 Lyrical

- Maroon Dress Costume
- Tan Tights
- Barefoot
- Accessory:
  - Flower Hairpiece
- Pinned to the RIGHT side of the bun



### **Grade 5-6 Tap**

- Pink Fringe Costume
- Tan Tights
- Jazz Shoes
- Accessory:
  - Scrunchie
    - Wrapped around the top of the bun

- Blue Dress Costume
- Tan Tights
