## Vaccination Clinic

SJC Health will be holding a vaccination clinic on Decatur Island, scheduled for **November 17th from 11 am to 1 pm**. The clinic will offer COVID and flu immunizations, but RSV (Respiratory Syncytial Virus) immunizations are not available at this time.

There have been changes in the COVID-19 vaccination distribution process. The COVID public health emergency declaration ended on May 11, 2023, leading to a shift from a public health response to a privatized medical management model. Under this new model, individual providers are responsible for purchasing their own supply of the COVID-19 vaccine from the manufacturer and must seek reimbursement through insurance companies. This change affects how COVID vaccinations are administered.

SJC Health will be providing the following vaccinations at the clinic:

- 1. Flu shots (regular and high dose) for all age groups.
- 2. COVID shots for individuals aged 6 months to 18 years old.
- 3. Adult COVID vaccines for individuals aged 19 and older who do not have health insurance.

For those with insurance, SJC has partnered with Ray's Pharmacy, which is capable of accepting insurance and billing accordingly for COVID vaccines for individuals aged 19 and older.

To help SJC Health and Ray's Pharmacy plan accordingly, individuals interested in receiving a vaccination are requested to send an email to Nicole Givan at <a href="mailto:nicoleg@sanjuanco.com">nicoleg@sanjuanco.com</a>. In the email, individuals should specify which vaccines they want for themselves and, if applicable, for their children, as well as whether they will be using insurance or not.
