The years he gave to his foster mom Steph and to each of us that loved him and followed his journey truly embodied our mission to do everything possible for our dogs. He was a big old Coonhound that wandered out of the Appalachian Mountains and made his way into each of our hearts.



Little Benson whose breed was indeterminable due to his horrible condition found a family that loved him until his last breath. Even though he was old and frail.



Bessie our Lemon Beagle who was riddled with mammary tumors and a myriad of other medical issues survived three years as a "forever" FOS dog.





Precious Zeke, found almost lifeless on a road in Virginia, spent his last week in a fabulous foster home, surrounded by love. Unfortunately, the damage of chronic disease was more than we could repair. He left us quickly but his time here was impactful and filled with sunny days, blue skies and anything his heart desired. It's hard to imagine he might have died alone on a cold, dark road and that he would never have touched our hearts.



And most recently, our perfect Polly Poppins. Her journey to become an FOS dog started after she had been tossed from a moving vehicle. A good samaritan found her and put out a plea for a rescue to help her. We stepped in, helped her heal, helped her regain trust in humans and helped her regain her confidence.
