

Grand Internationals VISA Application

Participants from outside Europe and North America

Generally - European countries, Canada, USA & Japan do not need a visa to enter Portugal

The following rules now apply to any and all groups wishing to attend the Grand Internationals in Portugal and need a Visa. These rules must be followed in order for us to assist with the Visa application. No exceptions.

Check with the Portugal Government website to see if do you need a visa at this URL and pay attention to area regarding Sports events, and also minors (under age 18 years):

Additional Tournament requirements:

- 1.The application for Visa MUST be made three months in advance.
- 2.You can only apply for the Visa when all the requirements are met in full below.
- 3.The federation and Coach must get a letter of confirmed Affiliation to the Sports Council of their respective country and or Olympic Council.
- 4.The Federation and instructor must pre-pay for their entries in the tournament online at MyUventex.com when online registration becomes live - BEFORE we assist with your application from the Visa Department and Embassy in the host country and Portugal. Note: If the Visa is denied for any reason we will refund your entry fees with proof provided, but if your team does not show up at the event there is no refund.
- 5.Details from a registered travel Agency regarding Arrival Date and Departure date, confirming reservation of Flight and Deposit paid on flights.
- 6.Payment of Accommodation reservation (In Advance) to one of the listed tournament hotels in Portimao.
- 7.The Federation and Chief Instructor then must get a letter of recommendation to attend the Grand Internationals for Their country. Which includes ALL the names of the proposed participants and digital copy of their passports.

Failure to comply with any and all of the above criteria will mean we will NOT be in a position to help VISA entry.
