- If you have not participated in HCA in the past, you are a new applicant to the program. The only guaranteed "New Applicants" considered for each new year are incoming Year I Freshman. All other "New Applicants" will be selected based on class seat vacancies.
- HCA is an intense 2-4-week program that offers a dual credit course. Because of this, it is
 important that applicants understand that there is no room for missing even one day of class.
 There is so much content packed into the summer course that missing one day is the equivalent
 of missing 3 weeks in a regular semester long scenario.
- Your GPA will be verified; if you aren't sure what it is, please put "unknown".
- FORWARD NM Dream Makers Program is for 8th grade students; if you do not know what this is, please simply mark "no" on the application.
