YOUR LIST WHEN DOING  
BUSINESS!

## Some tips to getting started, expanding, or renovating!

- Every business must have a business license to operate.
- Must have a NM Taxation & Revenue number.
- If they will be using signage, they must apply for a sign permit.
- Business must have a load inspection (decides how many people can be in the building at one time), by our local fire department.
- If building has been empty for over a year, business must
- have a Certificate of Occupancy inspection by the state Construction Industries Division.
- If type of business changes (example was a salon and now will be a restaurant), business must have a Certificate of Occupancy inspection by the state Construction Industries Division.
- If Business ownership changes, a new business license is required.
- If Business location changes, a new business license is required.
- If Business has more than one location, a business license is required for each location.
- If Business is in the Historic District, any changes to the façade, approval must be granted by the Landmark Commission through an application and meeting.
- Certain types of business required a special use permit for example: Cannabis, Mechanic Shop, Car Dealership etc..
