

NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

ON

PROPOSED FY 2027 COMMUNITY SERVICES BLOCK GRANT PLAN

The Human Development Commission will accept public comments as required by the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services CSBG State Plan for FY 2027. Public comments will be accepted on the FY 2027 CSBG proposed plan between May 4th, 2026 and May 18th, 2026.

The plan summary is as follows:

A total of \$446,396 is planned to be utilized in the four counties of Huron, Lapeer, Sanilac, and Tuscola for the general purposes of:

1. Employment opportunities for unemployed and underemployed persons.
2. Educational presentations and early childhood services.
3. Income management for low-income persons.
4. Housing resources for low-income individuals and families.
5. Emergency services for persons-in-crisis.
6. Nutritional food packages for persons vulnerable to malnutrition.
7. Linkages with other community resources, including services for the elderly.
8. Self-sufficiency through case management and family development services.
9. Health-related transportation services, especially for the elderly.
10. Program administration.
