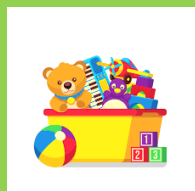
Christmas Gift for Kids

Elk's Christmas Baskets and Tree of Giving-Wallowa County

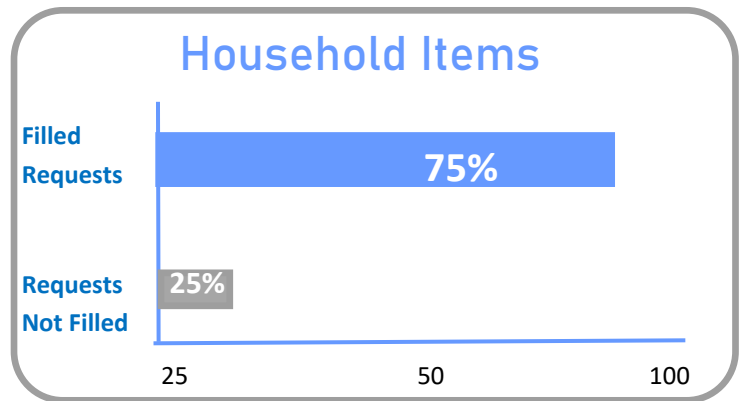
The local Elk's Chapter provides Christmas food baskets and presents to families in need from the Tree of Giving.

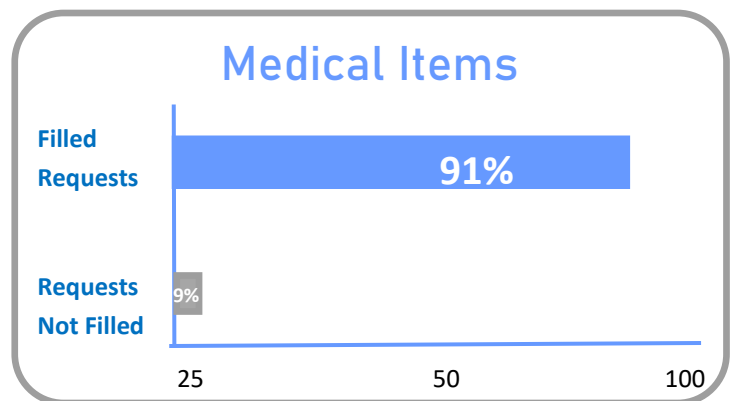


A Look at EOCRN Requests:

The Second Most Requested Items on EOCRN are Medical Items.

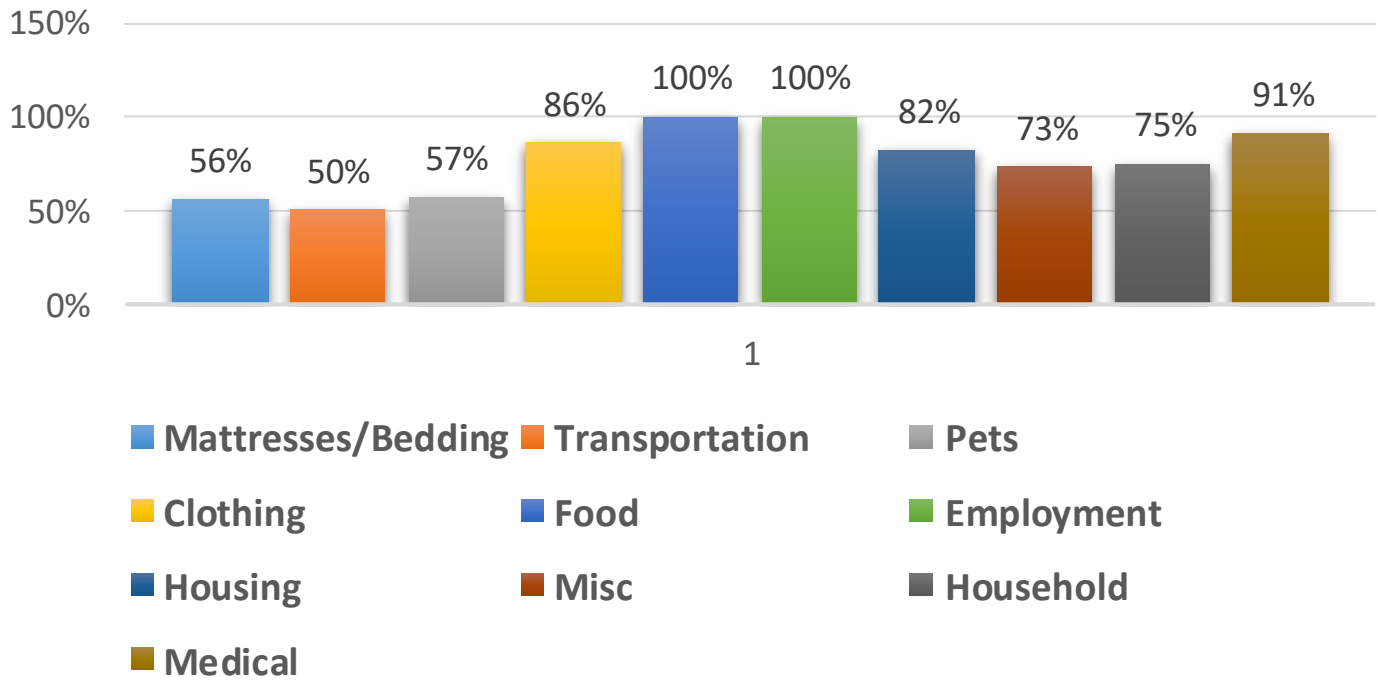


Hard to Fill Requests

There are many reasons a request might not get filled. It can vary from loss of contact with the person needing the item; the withdrawal of the request; or items that are difficult to obtain. In the household category, finding appliances can be challenging. The logistics of filling a transportation need or request can be difficult. Caring for pets has been another category difficult at times for meeting current needs.

However, **75% of total requests** have been filled and are making a difference in the lives of people in Eastern Oregon. The chart on the next page shows the different categories and success rate of filling the needs.
