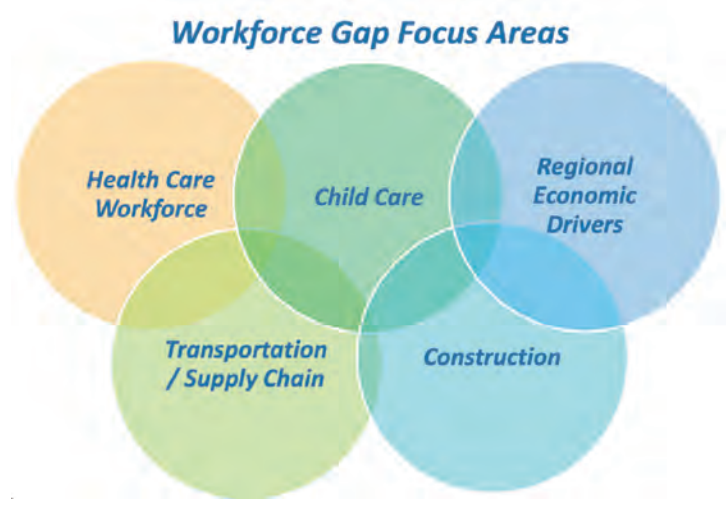




Prosperity 10,000+

Local Workforce Boards and their local partners in education, labor, training programs, and community based organizations.

HB4104 / Focused, fast tracked, evidence based.

HB4104 is the planned follow-up to Section 1 of SB623 (2021 Legislative Session).

- \$50 million in ARPA/General fund fast tracked to get funds on the ground asap to support and expand existing programs to identify potential trainees, provide training/skill development and wraparound services and get these candidates placed;
- Fast tracked using the "Project Turnkey" model. Funds allocated directly to DAS with a 30 day "clock" to distribute funds to legislatively created Local Workforce Boards, which pass through state and local funding to local service providers (i.e. apprenticeship programs, industry partnerships, community college programs, etc.);
- Focused on populations most impacted by COVID & the economic downturn, including communities of color, women, front line



lower-skilled workers, individuals with disabilities, youth, and those in poverty.

- Creates no new programs at the state level;
- Focus areas: healthcare, childcare, supply chain/transportation, construction, manufacturing (including cyber security) - - with flexibility to meet the specific needs of individual communities;
- Takes advantage of the new, statewide data collection and reporting system - - ITrac - - that has been implemented at all 9 Local Workforce Boards;
- Overseen by the broad, existing boards of LWBs - - all of which include higher education, labor, community based organization, non-profit, city/county, business, etc. partners.
- Track record of success: I.E. COVID small business grants from LWBs were out the door within 3 – 4 weeks in communities throughout the state.
