

Prosperity 10,000 Future Ready Oregon



The Eastern Oregon Workforce Board is distributing over \$800,000 in Prosperity 10,000 (P10k) funds to serve eastern Oregon residents.

Funds can be used to provide:

- Career coaching, occupational training, and job placement services
- Wraparound supports and services that are necessary to facilitate reengagement in the workforce, including, but not limited to, transportation, child care and rental assistance
- Paid work experiences, including stipends and wages and other income supports for individuals from priority populations
- Targeted recruitment and engagement efforts

The goals of the Prosperity 10,000 Program are to:

- (a) Include at least 10,000 total participants;
- (b) Improve the capacity and responsiveness of the public workforce system in this state by providing assistance for workforce development program navigation, expanding access to community-based career counseling and wraparound supports and services, and providing opportunities to earn industry-recognized certificates and credentials through work-based learning experiences;
- (c) Ensure that services and benefits available through workforce programs are provided to individuals from priority populations;
- (d) Provide increased access for priority populations to services and benefits available through workforce programs;
- (e) Provide opportunities for at least 50 percent of the participation by women;
- (f) Ensure that at least 80 percent of the participants successfully complete the program;
- (g) Ensure that at least 75 percent of the participants successfully obtain employment;
- (h) Ensure that at least 75 percent of the participants who successfully obtain employment earn at least \$17 per hour.
