#### <u>OregonSaves</u> Oregon State Treasury

Oregon's retirement savings program designed to provide employers with a simple way to help their employees save for the future. The program comes at no cost to employers, imposes no fiduciary responsibility, and requires minimal ongoing responsibilities. All Oregon employers without a qualified workplace savings option are required to register with OregonSaves. Enforcement action is expected to commence in 2024.

ODHS also provides childcare assistance through ERDC and low-cost healthcare coverage through OHP.

### <u>Recruit, Hire, Retain Veterans</u> Oregon Employment Department

Conducts outreach to employers and business associations.

Engages in advocacy efforts with hiring executives to increase employment opportunities for veterans & encourage the hiring of disabled veterans.

# <u>Employer Compliance</u> Worker's Compensation Division

## <u>Preferred Worker Program</u> Worker's Compensation Division

Promoting re-employment of qualified Oregon workers called preferred workers. The program gets funds from worker and employer payments into the Workers' Benefit Fund. Preferred workers can offer Oregon employers a chance to save money by hiring them.
