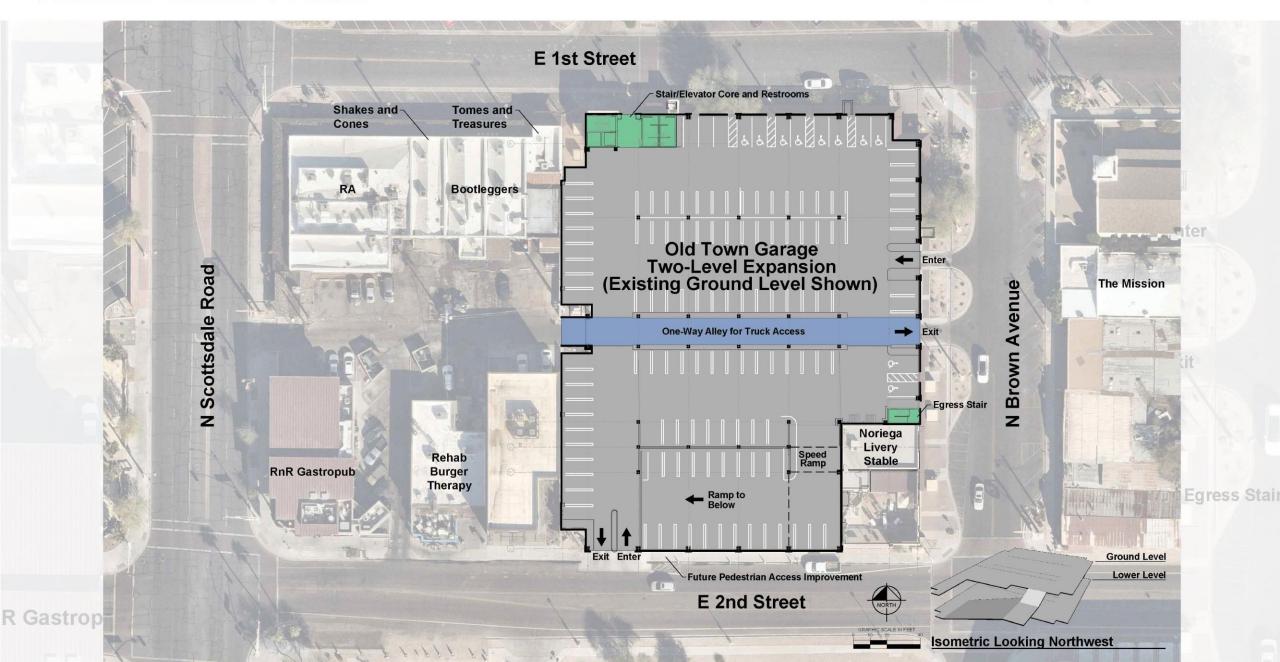

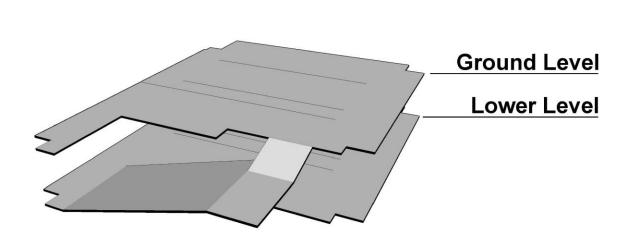




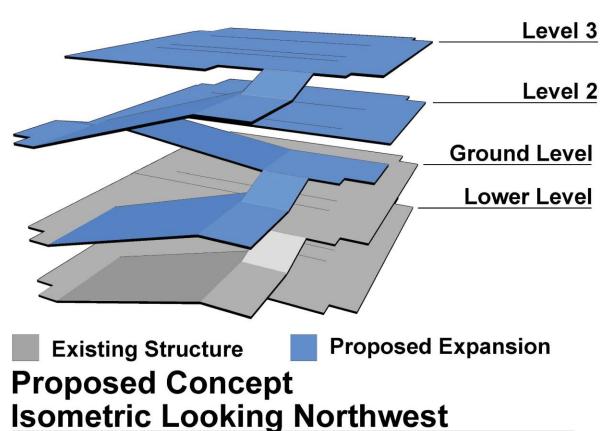








Existing Conditions Isometric Looking Northwest

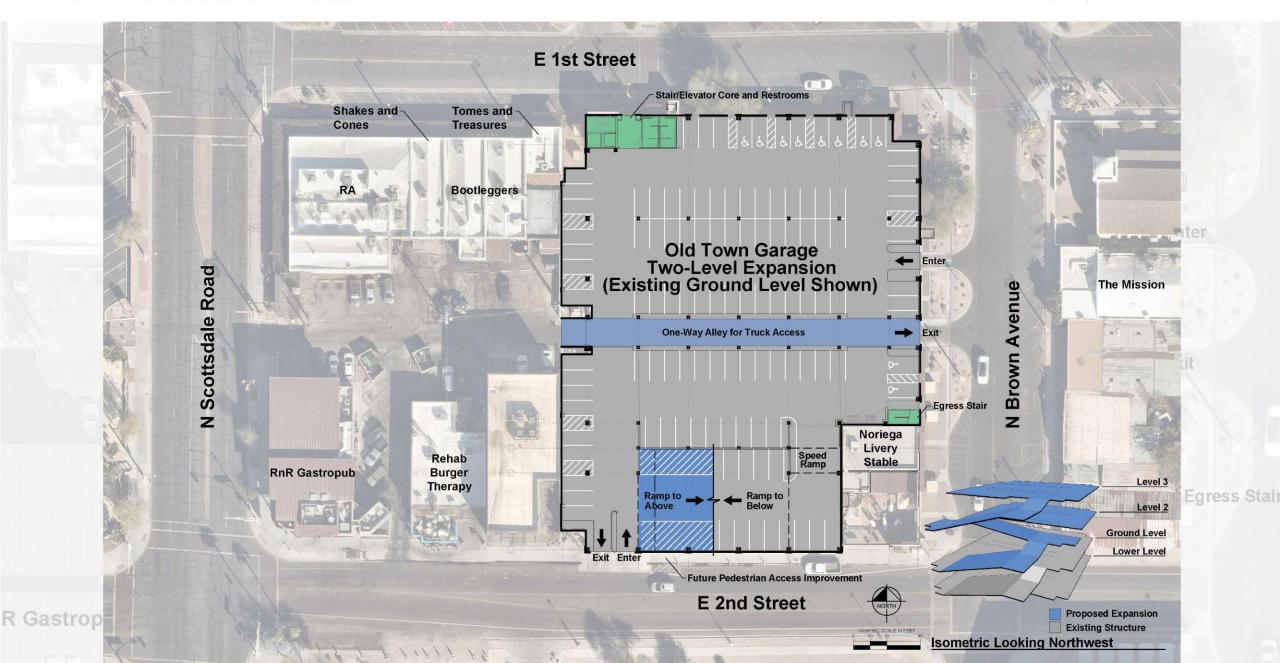

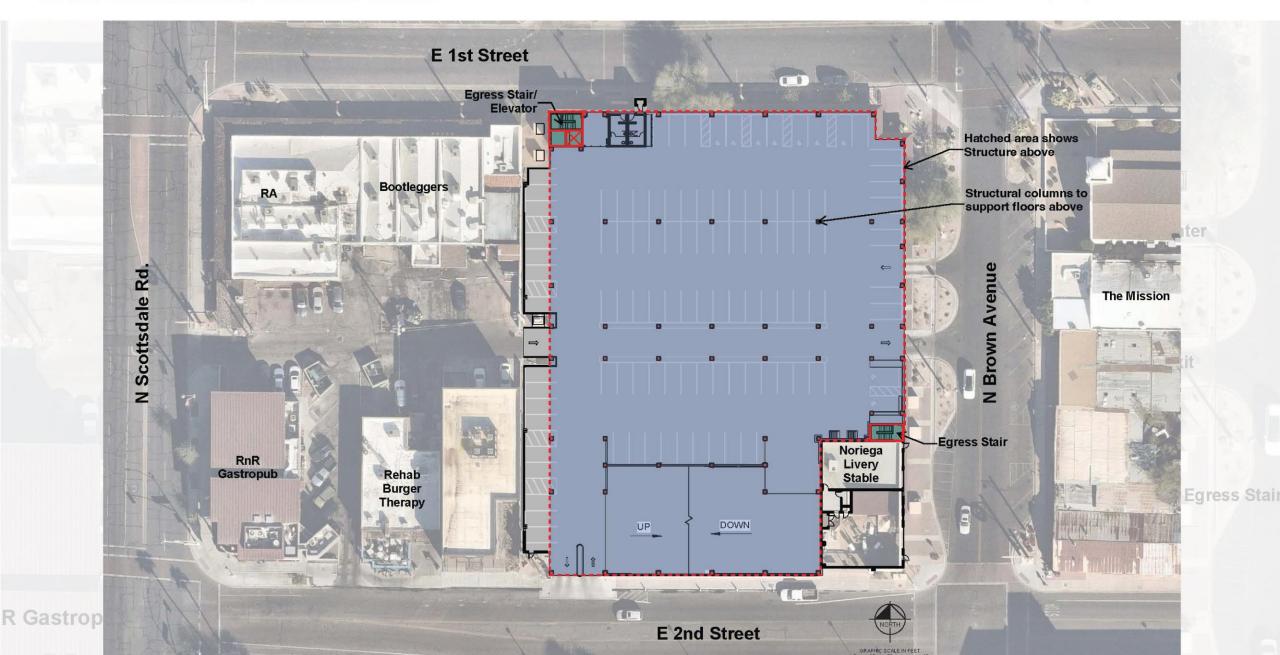


STRUCTURAL EXPANSION PLAN







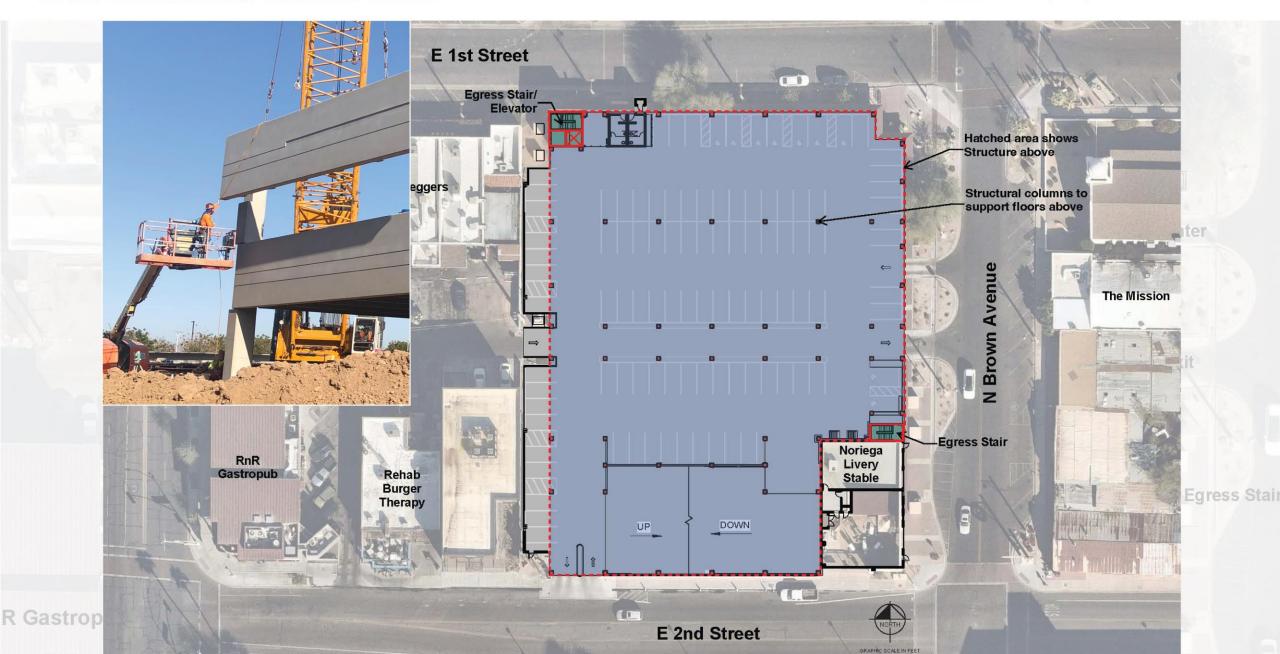

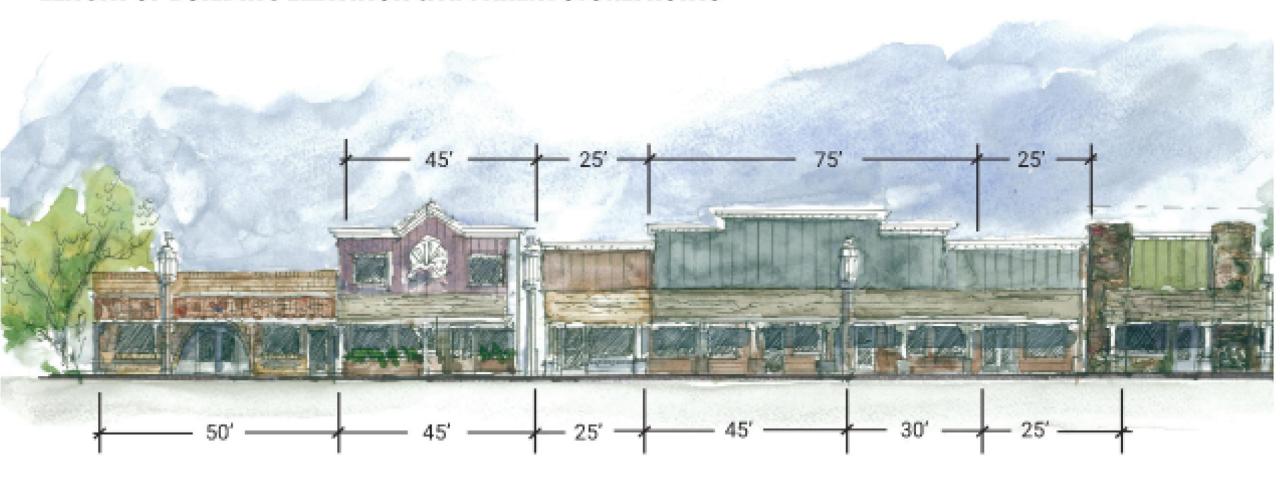
