A three-week outreach and public comment period was held in February and March of 2019, to educate Scottsdale Residents and property owners about the proposed Capital Improvement Projects the CIP Subcommittee is considering including in a possible bond election and solicit feedback on the proposed projects.

WEBSITE & ELECTRONIC FEEDBACK

The main source of information was the City's website with a feedback component. A new page was built on which each of the projects under consideration were listed with a description, financial information and a map.

COMMUNITY MEETINGS

During the public comment period, open houses will be held at various times and locations throughout the city. At the meetings several stations were be set up so that residents and property owners can come learn more about the proposed projects and get their questions answered. A bank of computers will be set up for participants to fill out the online questionnaire at the meeting or if they prefer, a paper version. There were no presentations made.
