1. Handicap is 135% - **SUGGESTION TO TAKE HANDICAP TO 100% OR 125%. YES – NO**
2. League starts January 25, 2023
3. One-Time Fees are as follows:
  - a. \$10 Towards the pot
  - b. \$20 Scorekeeper Fee
  - c. \$15 ACS Sanctioning (for those not sanctioned already)
4. Weekly dues are \$10 per player (or blind) or \$40 per week
5. If anyone wishes to be BCA sanctioned, please let us know and we will add you to the Open-Mix Tuesday league sanctioning. – **WOULD ANYONE LIKE TO DUAL SANCTION WITH ACS & BCA? YES – NO**
6. Unsportsmanlike financial consequence for a repeat offender: If anyone has more than a single warning, we will expect a payment of \$100 which will go towards the pot. This Penalty Fee must be payable upon transgression, before next game day. No payment, no playing. Player may be banned for a Session or a full year of League playing if the fee is not paid. If there is another offense, the fee will be raised to \$200.
  - a. Everyone will be looking out for unsportsmanlike behaviors. No one should ever become a threat to any of the participants. Not physically nor verbally. Keep your hands to yourself please.
7. Immediately after match is over when the two players shake hands remind each other to count balls and note on score sheet before both players walk away from table.
8. We are showing Option A, B, C as far as schedule and payouts accordingly.
  - a. We are assuming the same number of teams/ players. We updated the expenses as our overhead is way more than what we have been taking from all leagues in the last 15 years.
  - b. OPTION A is the most aggressive with maximum matches/ payout.
  - c. OPTION B is 2 rounds per year.
  - d. OPTION C is 3 rounds and has about a week off per month

9. CUE n BREW'S PRICE PER TEAM IS \$12. PLEASE PAY THE BARTENDER AT THE START OF LEAGUE.
10. Cue n Brew no longer offer a half time drink.
11. ON LEAGUE NIGHT BALLS WILL BE AVAILABLE AT 7:00PM. IF YOU WANT THEM EARLIER THAN 7PM, THE TABLE FEE IS \$4.
12. EACH PLAYER WILL USE THEIR LAST ESTABLISHED AVERAGE (PRIOR SEASON ENDING AVERAGE) UNTIL THEY HAVE 4 WEEKS OF PLAY. ONCE THE PLAYER HAS PLAYED 4 TIMES THAT DATA WILL BE USED TO ESTABLISH THEIR NEW AVERAGE AND IT WILL BE UPDATED WEEKLY.
13. NEW PLAYERS WILL PLAY FOR 4 WEEKS WITH THE STARTING AVERAGE OF 6.50 TO GET ESTABLISHED (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED BY DVPL).
14. If a player takes first in The Most Improved and Top Shooter category, she will receive both prizes.
15. We will continue to issue a proposed payout, if anyone has a suggestion, we will look at it and if the League sees fit to make any changes that benefits all players, we will do so.
16. No one is to e-mail the captains on their own. If there is something anyone wants to share it must go to league directors first.
17. We will pay top 5 females, 1 most improved (plaque or \$50) and every single team.
18. We welcome new and returning players to join us at any time of league session except on position rounds.
19. For unknown players we want to suggest an average of 6.5 and for known top players we will assign high handicap (8-9).
20. Time-out rule: Applying the time-out rule is a cordial agreement between players. 60 seconds will serve as the time-out limit. A single time out per game is allowed; the following are the guidelines:
  - a. Time-out to be called by shooter at the table only.
  - b. Shooter should address your opponent and let them know you are calling a time-out before consulting a teammate.
  - c. If any other player from the team of the shooter suggests a time-out it will be considered a coaching foul and a ball in hand shall be awarded to the other player. Please share this with friends and teammates as they will cost you a foul if they are not aware of the rule.
  - d. When you call for a time out only ONE player should exchange information with you - not an entire team.
  - e. The non-shooting player is NOT allowed to engage in conversation with teammates while an opponent's time-out is in progress.
  - f. If the opponent is timing your time-out will give you a 10 second warning. Thereafter, if you do not complete your time-out within the 60 second rule it is now a foul and your opponent shall get ball in hand.
  - g. If a full team of 5 or more shows up to the match and a time out is called, even though only 4 players are playing the match, any of the 5 teammates that are there can be called upon for the time-out.

- h. Some players do not time their opponent's time-out. Please advise your opponent if you will be timing them.
21. There can be a time limit imposed on slow players. 60 seconds will serve as a guideline for individual shots. If it is observed that a player is playing slow, the captain of the opposing team may go to the captain of the slow player and notify them. The captain of the slow player is to tell his/her player to speed up his/her play OR a shot clock of 60 seconds may be applied to BOTH PLAYERS for the REMAINDER of their GAME. Once a shot clock is invoked in a game, it must apply to both players for the rest of the game, if it's going to be considered fair.
  22. All teams will be charged fees for a minimum of 4 players whether they all have 4 weeks played or not.
  23. We will draw numbers for teams.
  24. Folders will be distributed on first or second week.
  25. We promote league playing, new players, new sponsors, new clinics, new leagues, new tours etc.
  26. We do NOT promise the same sponsors to any one especially if you take a break during the year and other teams do not. If a team takes a season off their home bar is up for grabs.
  27. We reserve the right to move your matches as needed to cover our sponsors.
  28. Fees will be due latest at the middle of the session. After this date scorekeeper will be able to penalize teams.
  29. We will continue not to have limit on singles blinds, but we will allow 2 double blinds only.
  30. For the end of the league tourney, we will do a blind draw for this final event, handicap applies, and each player will pay \$10.
  31. When a ball goes off the table, the ball gets spotted, it is a loss of turn, and it is not a ball in hand. Excluding the 8 ball.
  32. Starting time for all matches is 7:30. If there is not a full team by 7:45 blinds are to be used. At 8:00 if there still are not enough players to play the match the match is considered a forfeit unless there has been any kind of communication with the other team or league representatives. If there has been communication, please try to work it out and avoid forfeits. Remember we all come from work and are trying to make it to pool and sometimes life happens.
  33. SPONSORS CONVERSATIONS: WE WANT TO ENCOURAGE THE CAPTAINS TO ENGAGE YOUR SPONSORS TO GET THEM TO CONTRIBUTE TO OUR PAYOUTS. FOR THIS LONG SESSION THESE WERE THE SPONSORS WHO CONTRIBUTED: OFFICE \$200, VINNIE'S \$200. CLAYTON'S \$200, CUE N BREW \$100, ARTIE'S SPONSOR DID NOT CONTRIBUTE FOR WOMEN'S PAYOUT.
  34. WHEN WE HIT AN EARLY 8 BALL AND WE HAVE NOT MADE A SOLID OR A STRIPE, WHAT SHOULD THE RULE BE? RE-RACK AND NO SCORE TO ANYONE? SHOULD THE PLAYER WHO MADE THE EARLY 8 BALL LOSE THE GAME? SHOULD THE SCORE BE 7-8 RATHER THAN 15-0?

35. PLAYERS ATTENDING ACS OR BCA NATIONALS SHALL RE-IMBURSE THE LEAGUE WITHIN 4 WEEKS OF PLAY.
36. SCRATCH OF CUE BALL. ACS IS BEHIND THE KITCHEN. CAN ALL CAPTAINS ACKNOWLEDGE THIS PLEASE.
37. WE HAVE A NEW SPONSOR WHO WOULD LIKE TO HOST (12) WOMEN'S TEAMS. (MR. LEE CHICKEN)
