2. Looks like blinds are being managed well. Only one team got close to penalty phase. No changes.
3. We have received communication from several captains to impose a ZERO tolerance to violence within our league. Anyone who raises a hand against a fellow player, will be expulsed and will never be able to play in this league again, regardless of who initiated the altercation. The two players involved will be at fault.

4. What does "home team advantage" mean?
a. If you are home team, you chose the tables you want to want to play on.
b. If you are at home team, you allow the visitor team to fill up the line up first.
c. If you are home team, the visitor team takes the envelope to Vinnie's bar at the end of the night.
d. If the captains do not agree on tables, cue balls, etc a coin flip usually works. Work it out please.
5. Women participating on the open-mix league shall start with a 6.5 average. If we know a set skill set higher than that we will decide starting average based on Fargo, and knowledge of the player. Keep at 7.0?

6. Some captains are not happy with the high handicap they are having to give up. It was suggested to add a CAP to the number of balls being given. YES - NO (20 BALL MAX?)
7. Another solution to the high handicap will be to lower the handicap. YES-NO $(130 \%, 140 \%$ ? $)$
8. Rather than drawing numbers for teams at the captains meeting, we will use the order which we finished the previous session. This works best for our internal scheduling.
9. To qualify for most improved list, Players will have to play a minimum of 8 matches ( 32 games).
10. Due to the lack of accuracy with Fargo System files we receive from BCA, we are looking into joining the LMS (league managing system). This process will allow players to input their scores at the end of the league play and all the information will be online. Are players interested in us trying it? If agreed on we will all go through a learning process as to how to navigate it. One of the advantages of the system is when we add a new player in the LMS database, they are also created in the Fargo Rate and CSI databases the following day. YES-NO
11. As of $3 / 31$ we know of (two new teams forming). Anyone else interesting in branching out and making a new mix MUST communicate with us so we can assign sponsor bars available.
a. Lee Atkins (new group of players) will be playing out of Farrington's Bar
b. Alissa Linquist (returning group of players) playing out of Arties.
12. We also have a new Sponsor Pineda's Bar (Pittsburgh) with two tables. We have (1) team going there.

13. The Office Sponsor has expressed discontent with teams forgetting to pay for the table and has decided to only pay for a single team, we will go with the team who has been part of the league the longest. (Jim Avila's team).

## PLAYERS INPUT

- The men coming in who have no established average in the league should be an eight, the women should stay at seven if they have no established average without playing in our league, I think you should do Fargo rating also in the payout if you want just a little bit higher that'll be OK
- My recommendation to change the handicap.

Everyone played better this season as you can see by the stats.
The spot should be the difference between the 2 team averages. NO 1.5 multiplier. Why look at the math

Team A = 36 avg. every player is $\sim 9$
Team $B=26 a v g$. every player is $\sim 6.5$
(36-26= Difference is 10 balls per round)
10balls / 4players = 2.5
The lower team is getting 2.5 balls added to their avg. bringing their avg $=$ to Team A $6.5+2.5=9$
Anything more than 10 balls. Team B gets the advantage.
The Max spot any team should get is 12 balls per round or 3balls per player.

- (from the sponsor The Office) Please make sure both teams pay for table time before play starts moving forward. That way there are no issues. Also, I will only be sponsoring one team moving forward.

## EXISTING GUIDELINES

1. Deadline to be under the limit of $\$ 80$ owed by $1 / 2$ way point of the season. At that point we start charging the 1 round point penalty each week a team is over the limit.
2. If a team does not have an opponent on position rounds, they will get no free rounds, and no fees are due.
3. Forfeits - We will use the average round points +1 if the forfeit occurs within the last 8 weeks of league. Prior to the last 8 weeks the rule is automatic 5 rounds to the non-forfeiting team.
4. The players are to always show sportsmanlike behavior and never disrespect the bar, its patrons, or the players.
5. No new players after $1 / 2$ point of season without approval. If they have played with us in the past, there is an existing average. We are bringing this rule back and will enforce it. Please remember to add full names on the score sheet.
6. Penalty from bringing a new player after half session without approval will be loss of any rounds scored by the player.
7. Women's best shooters pays top 3 .
8. Cells phones are not allowed while watching a bad hit.
9. Handicap is $150 \%$
10. We have two position rounds one in the middle of the session and one at the end.
11. The floater alternate concept will continue based on need. Alternate has no financial obligation unless agreed with captain. Contact us asap when in need.
12. Players to purchase a drink full prize to qualify for the half free drink from the sponsors who still honor it. Players, please tip your bartenders.
13. League starts at 7:30. If anyone wants to play before $7: 00 \mathrm{pm}$ they will have to pay sponsor's regular price.
14. We will continue to use the same rules whenever ties between teams are to be resolved. Position round matches are not used in resolving ties.
15. Tie breaker \#1 - Whichever team won the most round points when they played against each other during the regularly scheduled match/matches. We will however split the money evenly between the teams.
16. Tie breaker \#2 - To only be used if Tie Breaker \#1 didn't resolve the tie. Count the number of games won between the two teams from the match/matches when they played against each other.
17. Tie breaker \#3 - To only be used if Tie Breaker \#1 \& \#2 didn't resolve the tie. Count the total number of games won by the teams that are tied for the entire season.
18. When it comes to selecting who plays a blind the team with 4 players gets to select who will play the blind. The blind shall always be on the 4 rth position.
19. End of year Tourney. Will do a blind draw, single round. Everyone will pay $\$ 10$ to enter plus the money saved from main payout. Handicap applies.
20. All returning players will use established averages where they left last session.
21. When you asked someone to watch a hit, no one else shall have a say on it. Also, we only want a single player doing it.
22. This is BCA sanctioned league, you play, you pay. One-time League Fees are as follows:
i. \$20 Scorekeeper fee
ii. $\$ 20 \mathrm{BCA}$
iii. \$10 Towards the pot
iv. $\$ 50$ Total
23. All Captains need to know the rules, posted on website. It is your responsibility to know DVPL's guidelines.
24. Unsportsmanlike behavior is not tolerated in our leagues. For a 1st offense you will receive one warning. For a second offense the player will be suspended for 4 weeks of play. For a 3rd offense you will be invited to go elsewhere.
25. No one is to e-mail the captains on their own. If there is something anyone wants to share it must go to league directors first.
26. Cue and Brew charges $\$ 12 /$ team, please pay in ADVANCE at the beginning of league to avoid anyone forgetting to pay. On league night balls will be available at 7:00 pm. If you want them earlier than 7:00 pm , the table fee is $\$ 4$.
27. Single blinds are 7 max and no double blinds, allowed. We will keep the single double blind for emergencies as I see they were used by some teams.
28. Score keeper appreciates the captains to continue to send the photos of the score sheets the same day of play or the next one.
29. All new male players will start as 8 's and women's as $6.5^{\prime}$ s. They will play for 4 weeks before they can be established.
30. We played 3 weeks with the average of previous session. On week 4 we started using our adjusted average. All established players will carry their averages from previous session or the last session where at least 3 matches ( 12 games) were played if they did not play in the spring. Only new players will play for 3 weeks to get established.
31. We pay our most improved players, top 3 most improved men \& Top 3 most improved women.
32. League plays $7: 30 \mathrm{pm} .8: 00 \mathrm{pm}$ is the latest time for a player to show up. Captains, please communicate, coordinate, re-schedule etc.
33. We will continue to track sponsors payment. We received all payments for this session, so payout was not affected.
34. We thank the captains that get involved in the conversations with the sponsors.
35. When we hit an early 8 Ball and we have not made a solid or a stripe, The rule It's a loss of game and you get the most balls made added to your score.
36. The Office Sponsors only wants 2 teams for this league.
37. Owner from Cj's and Farrington's wants (2) teams.
38. Retro Junkie sponsor in Walnut Creek wants (2) teams.
39. The time out is to be called by the player only.
40. We reviewed the payouts to distribute the money more evenly among teams.
41. DVPL reserves the right to refuse participation to anybody that we believe has a poor sportsman like behavior or owes money. Warnings will remain in effect for 1 year from warning date. We have stablished rules. Refer to master rules if needed, however the minutes take precedence.
