

# 2021-22 No-Cost Defensible Space Assistance Program



Need support clearing 100' of defensible space around your home? Let us help!

**This program was created to help low-income seniors and/or physically disabled persons adhere to defensible space regulations.**

- Must be over 65 or have a medical physical disability making it impossible for you to do the clean-up work yourself.
- Must be deemed financially unable to hire a contractor:  
One-person household: Income is less than \$2,842 (monthly) or \$34,100 (annually)  
Two-person household: Income is less than \$3,246 (monthly) or \$38,950 (annually)

## What is provided in our Defensible Space Assistance Program?

- Initial one-day defensible space clean up.
- Brush and tree trimming/thinning.
- Raking of dead leaves and pine needles.
- Chipping of removed vegetation. Chips are left onsite.
- On-site education about effective defensible space.
