 - i. ATEC company is coming out June 19th to do the testing on the water to see if their system can get the manganese and iron out of the water.
 - ii. If ATEC works, we will go out for bids to see if any other companies can do treatment.
 - iii. We will hire a Project Engineer, to help us engineer a system that the State of California will sign off on. Once we decide on a system, we will go the residents and see if they would agree to an increase in their property taxes to pay for the system.

- iv. The ATEC system will use chlorine to clean the water. Chlorine will be mandated by the State by the year 2025.
- v. Well #10 has tested positive for Total Coliform, a bacterium in the water. Buddy has sanitized it twice and the well is currently offline. This positive testing has put us in the "C" category for problem water.
- vi. Well #11 proposed generator-the State came out to see what type of diesel generator would work. It will take approximately a year to get this project completed. The WWD received a grant to purchase a generator for Well #11. This generator will help keep the WWD resilient against power outages.
- vii. We are also inquiring about transfer switches for the wells. By
- viii. Well #9 generator still does not work. The generator given to us by SDG&E is for a home and is not sized correctly for the usage we need.
