# How Much Is Registration?

For the 2025 season, the following registration fees apply (all prices are inclusive of GST):

# What Does the Registration Fee Include?

It enables you to participate in the FQ Northern season competition and train in a safe, equipped and fully maintained environment. It provides appropriate insurance cover as mandated by Football Australia. Players will also receive a training shirt.

# **Sibling Discounts**

For the 2025 season, Estates are offering the following sibling discounts:

 $1^{st}$  Child - Full Price  $2^{nd}$  Child - \$20 off  $3^{rd}$  Child - \$30 off  $4^{th}$  Child - \$40 off  $5^{th}$  Child - \$50 off

**NOTE:** Sibling discounts only apply across the same registration product due to a Squadi system limitation.

# **FairPlay Vouchers**

Parents, carers, or guardians can apply for a voucher valued up to \$150 for their child, which can be used towards sport and active recreation membership, registration, or participation fees. There is a limit of 1 voucher per child per calendar year.

Once you have received your FairPlay voucher, please enter the voucher details when registering via Squadi to have the \$150 deducted from the amount payable.

## What Payment Options Are Available?

- Payment in full via Squadi upon registering
- Afterpay is available
- Pay by instalments

If choosing the pay by instalments option, you will be required to make an upfront payment of the total governing body fees + the first instalment amount. The remaining balance is then to be paid via monthly instalments in February, March, April, May, and June. These dates are set in stone by Football Queensland and are unable to changed.

**NOTE:** all payments are required to be made by either Squadi or Afterpay; payments made directly to the club will not be accepted.

#### **Squadi Transaction Fees**

The following transaction fees apply.

Direct Debit: A transaction fee of 2.00% + up to 60c applies (capped at \$10) Credit Card:

A transaction fee of 2.50% + up to 60c is charged for domestic credit cards and 4.00% + up to 60c for international. For American Express cards a fee of 2.85% + up to 60c applies.

A minimum charge of 50c will apply to each registration or instalment transaction.

## **Afterpay Fees**

Estates does not impose any fees to customers for utilising Afterpay services. However, Afterpay impose their own fees; please familiarise yourself with the <u>Afterpay Terms of Service</u>.

#### **Squadi Support**

Football Queensland have released numerous guides to assist with navigating and registering within Squadi. Please utilise the <u>FQ Squadi Guides</u> in first instance should you encounter any issues.

#### What Is FQPL & Community League?

FQPL stands for Football Queensland Premier League and is the 'A Grade' competition within the respective age groups. Community League is where 'B and C Grade' teams compete. The competitive age group starts from U13 to seniors (i.e. table of points is kept and players participate in finals).

# Does My Daughter Have to Be in An All-Girls Team?

No, but it is preferred by the club for most female players. If the club gets enough female numbers to create a team in an all-girls competition (should they exist), we recommend they play in a girls' team as preference.

#### Where Is Training Held?

All trainings are held at Victoria Park, South Townsville.

# When Does Training Start, What Days & Time?

Keep an eye out on our social media pages and website for training commencement dates. Trainings are generally held on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons; however, this is dependent on coaches' availability. Players will be advised of training days and times for their specific team, once teams are confirmed (this will occur in early February).

# What Do Players Wear to Training/Games?

It is compulsory for players to wear shin pads for games and training. Caps, watches, and jewellery is not permitted – bucket hats are acceptable. Players are encouraged to wear their training shirts to training and club polo to games.

Estates provide teams with playing shirts to use for the season. Players will be required to purchase playing shorts (excluding FQPL Men, FQPL U23 Men & FQPL Women) and socks; these are available from <a href="https://www.ultrafootball.com/collections/estates-fc">https://www.ultrafootball.com/collections/estates-fc</a> - additional matchday apparel including jackets, compression tops and bags can also be purchased via Ultra Football.

Club polo shirts, supporter ware and additional merchandise can also be purchased from the canteen.

#### Where Are Games Held?

All MiniRoos and Junior games are held at Paradise Park, Murray Sporting Complex in Annandale. Game times will be available once FQ Northern have published a draw in the Squadi.

## **Do Coaches Receive Anything for Volunteering?**

Yes. Our club coaches will receive a free shirt. Estates will provide support for coaches to complete suitable training courses to further their development.

#### Do I Need a Blue Card to Coach or Manage?

Yes. Every coach/manager for our club is required to obtain a Blue Card. You MUST have this card before you can start coaching or managing your team.
