This past summer, the Sonoma County Library launched a new resource-sharing service called LINK+ (LINK Plus). This service allows patrons to borrow books and media not available at Sonoma County Library. LINK+ combines the library holdings of 70 California and Nevada public and academic libraries. Patrons can request materials from any of the LINK+ libraries and they will be delivered to our Sonoma County Library branches. LINK+ offers our patrons access to over 9 million items, including new books and media (DVDs, Books on CD, music CDs, Playaways and video games) and many other unique items. This has been a very popular service and worth trying our for yourself!

Lana, our Division Manager, has also been working with us to help plan and prepare for the mini-refresh that is coming soon. The new teen area now in the planning stages will also be a welcome upgrade!

### **Treasurer's Report**

Report for the period August 11 through October 23, 2019

Since August 11, the August Book and Bake Sale made \$3,306.75, and the Comic Book Sale yielded \$644.66

Our online book vendor produced \$749.65. Forum Room bookshelves netted \$289.10.

Our biggest expense has been volunteer expenses, including refreshments and the Volunteer Appreciation Picnic, at \$1,230.55. Postage and Printing expenses came to \$1,158.25.

Our balance as of October 23 is \$47,443.28
